## LIVING ROOMS

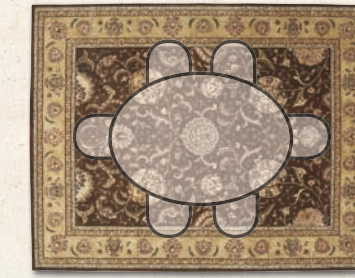
Providing measurements of the room and furniture dimensions ensures you get the right rug for the room.

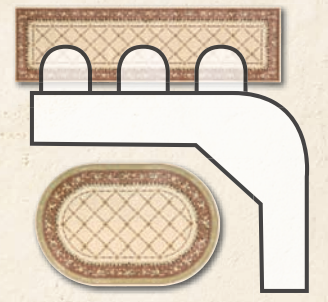

8' x 10' rectangle or oval



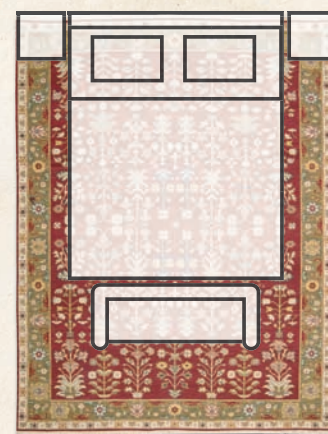
8' or 10' Shape



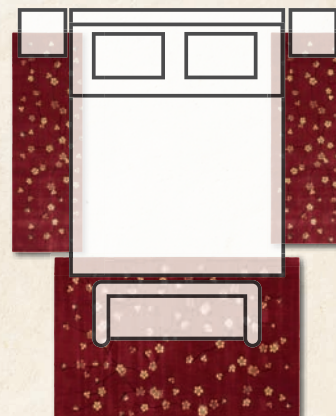
8' runner and 4' x 6' Kitchen counter & stools

Make sure your rug is large enough for any extra leaves in the table. Leave 18-24 inches of rug on all sides, for chairs to get pushed back.



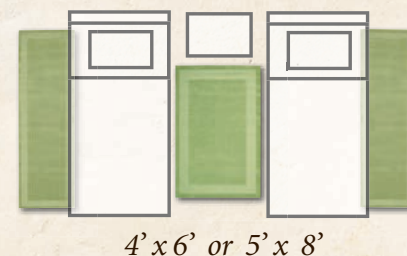

8' x 11' or 9' x 12'



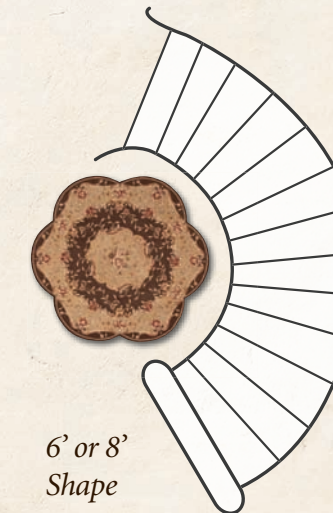
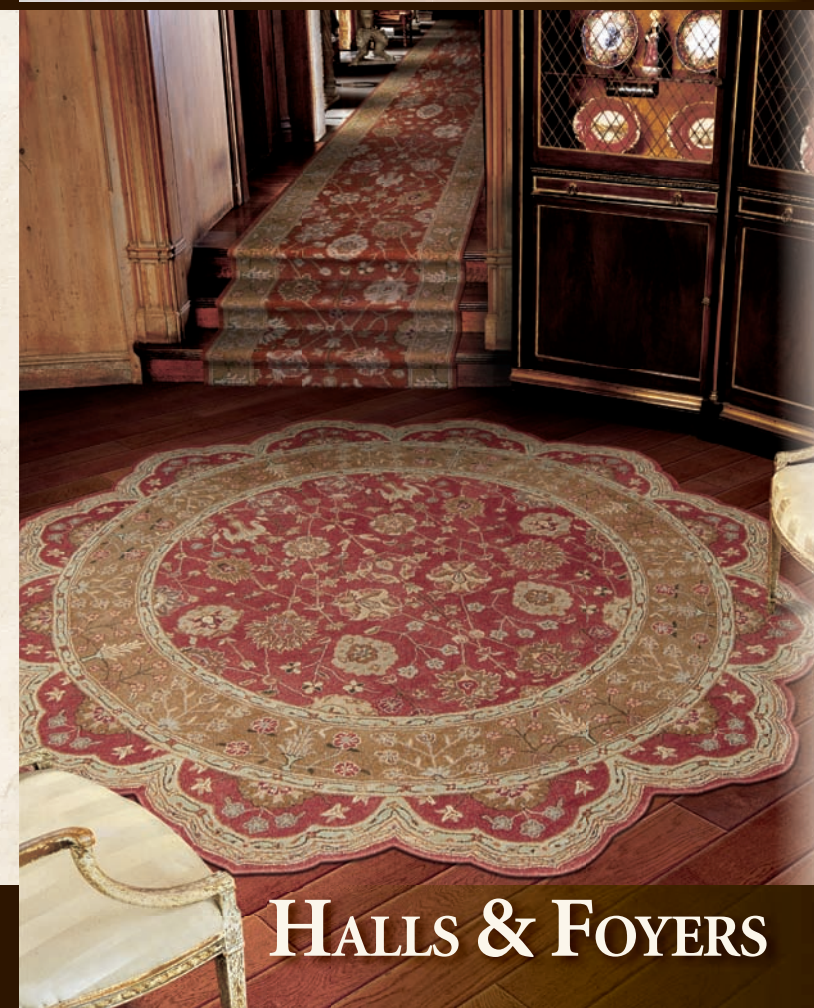
4' x 6' or 5' x 8' and runners



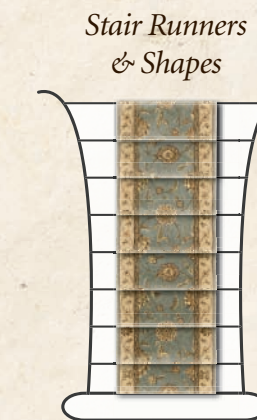
