Tap Them In.

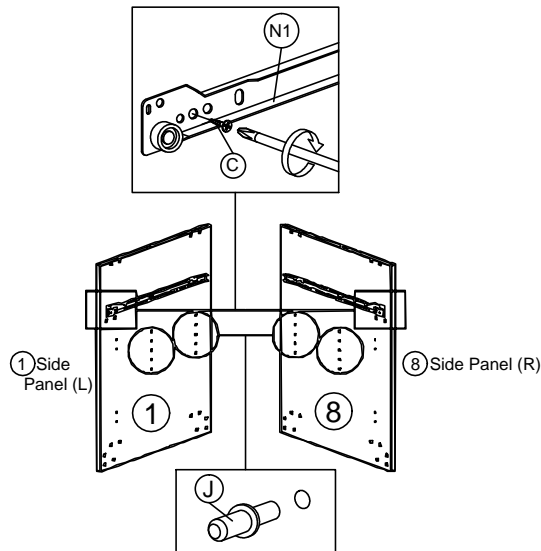


Tighten Minifix (12) To Panel

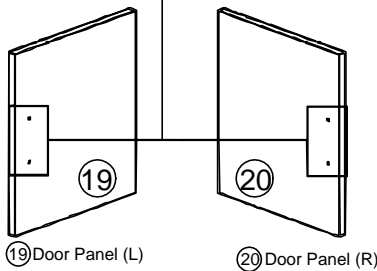
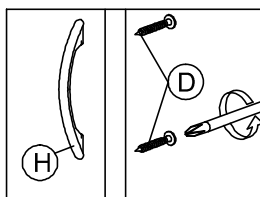
Place The Drawer Slide On To 3 Holes Area Shown At Right Side Panel (1). Then Tighten It With 3 Screw (C).



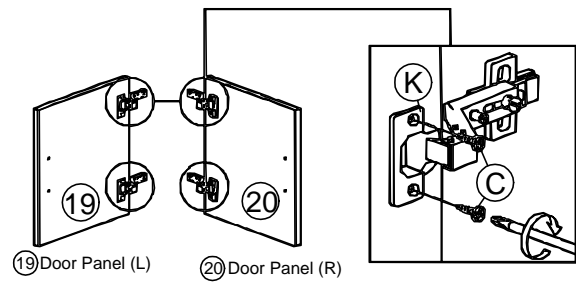
Place The Drawer Slide On To 3 Holes Area Shown At Right Side Panel (8). Then Tighten It With 3 Screw (C).

Tighten 2 Screw (D) From Door Panel (19, 20) Into The Handle (H) Hole.

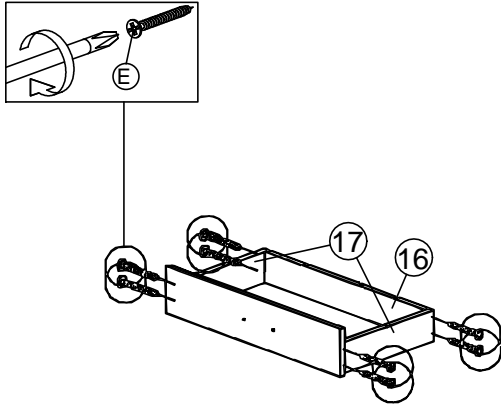

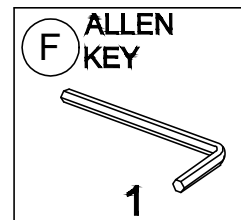
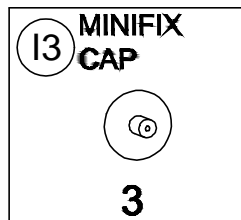
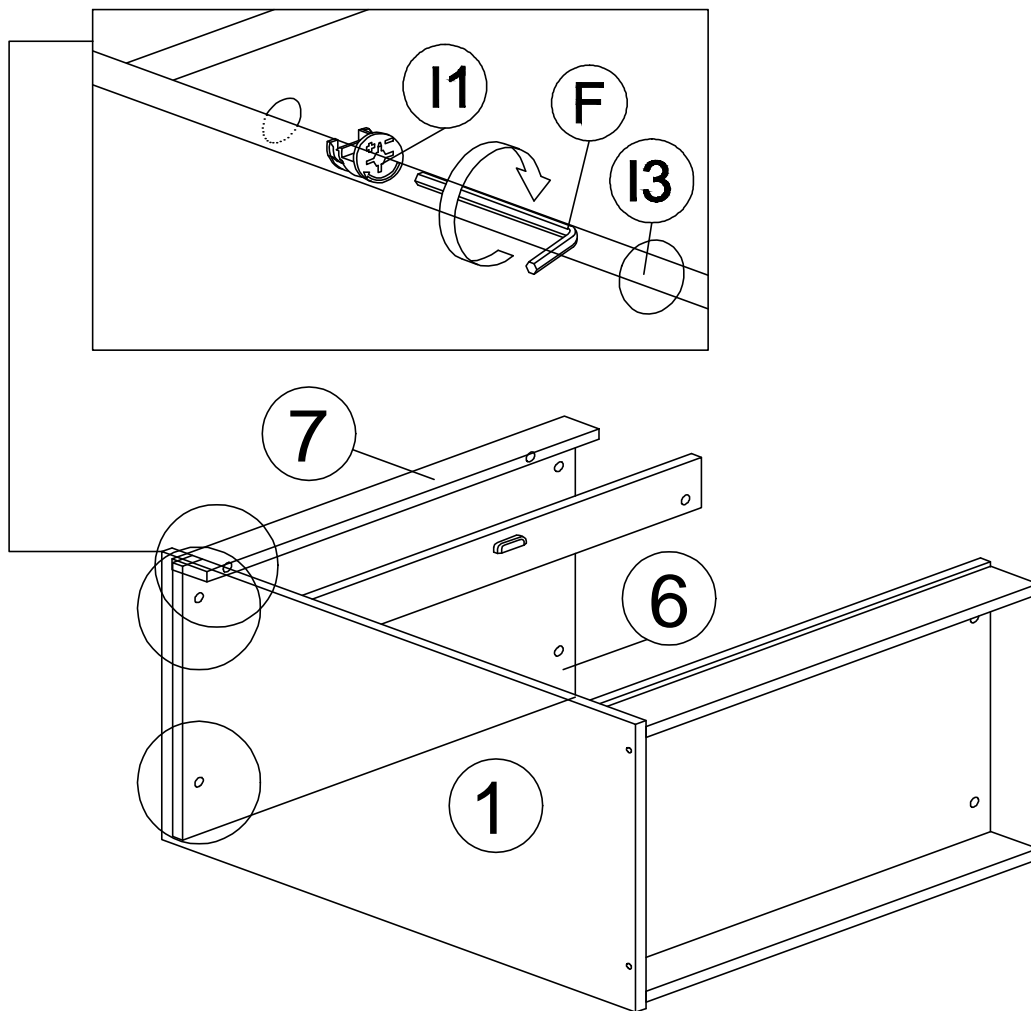
Assembly Instruction Step 3

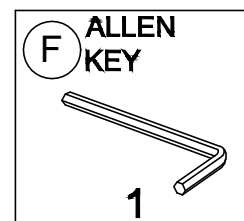
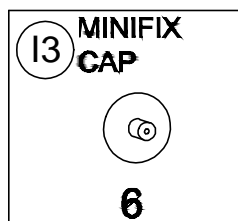
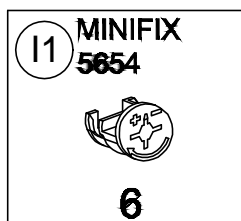
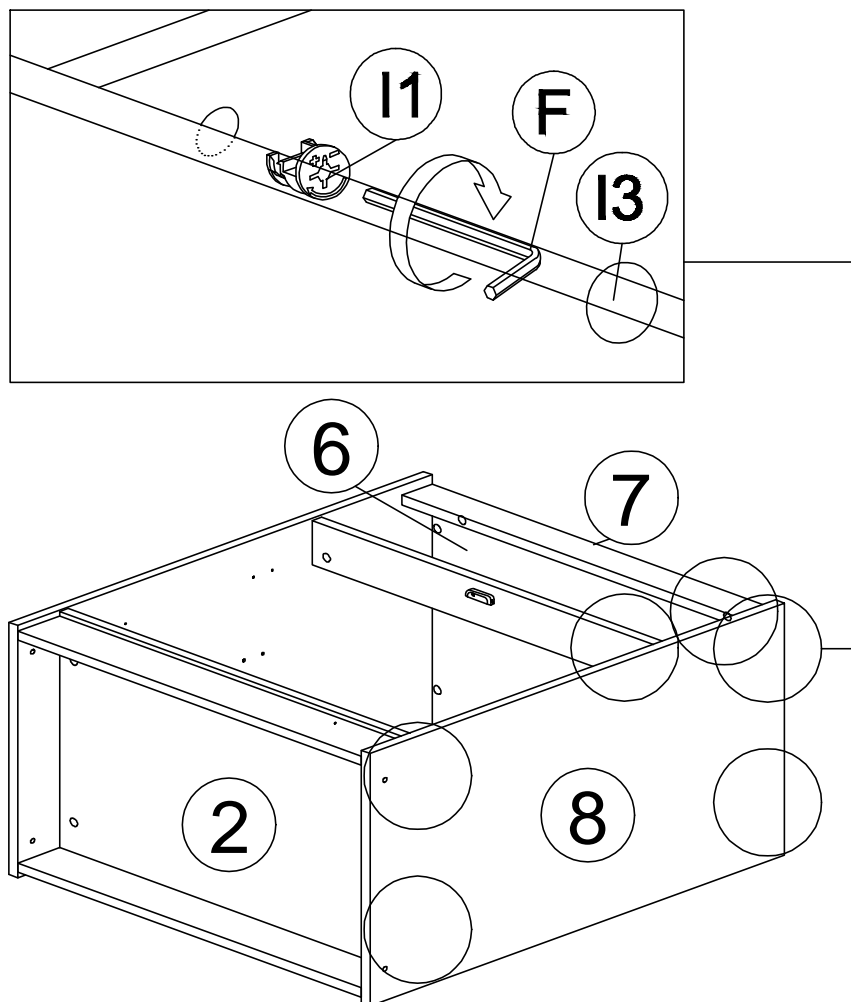
Assembly Instruction Step 4

Fix Panel (6,7) Onto Panel (1) By Inserting Minifix (I1) Into Panel (6,7) 's L-thru Holes And Using Allen Key (F) To Tighten It After That Insert Minifix Cap (I3).



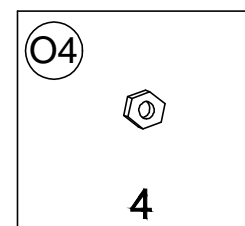
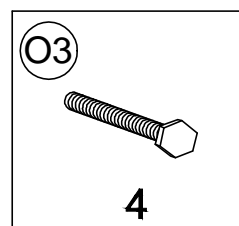
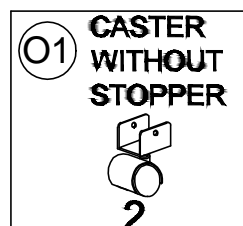
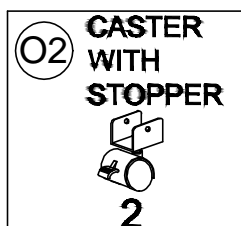
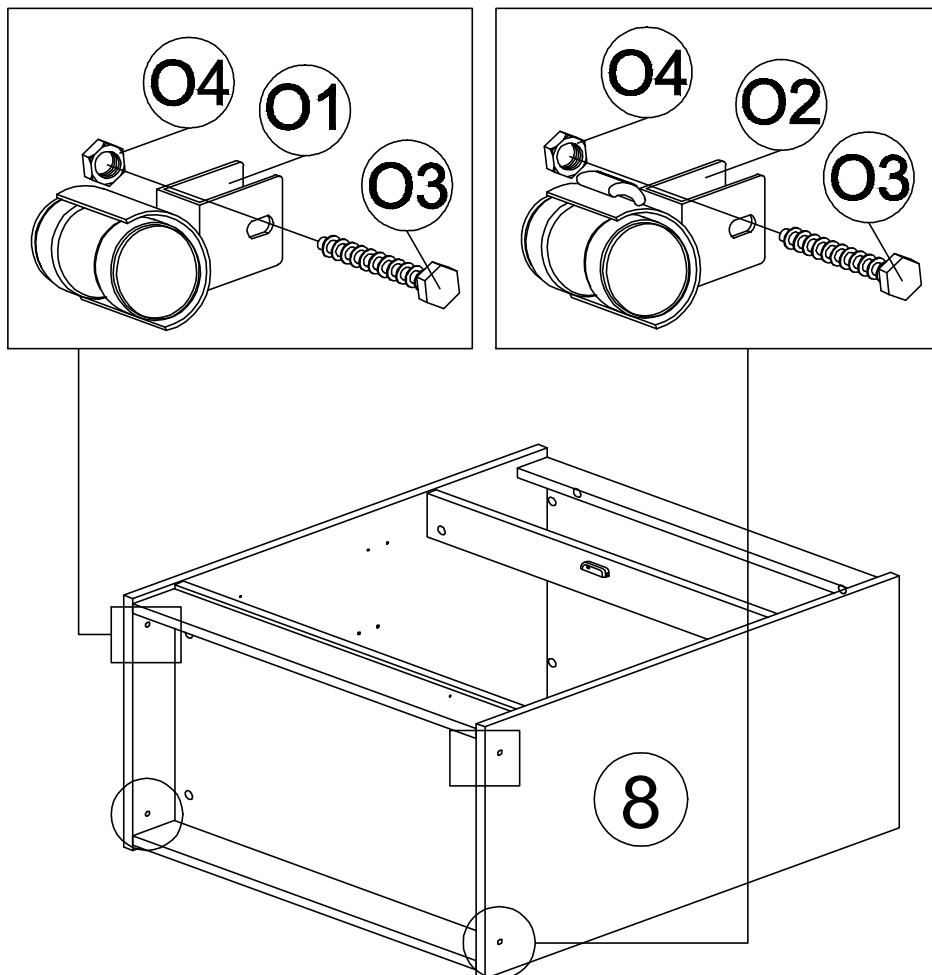
Assembly Instruction Step 5

Fix Panel (2,6 and 7) Onto Panel (8) By Inserting Minifix (I1) Into Panel (2,6 and 7) 's L-thru Holes And Using Allen Key (F) To Tighten It After That Insert Minifix Cap (I3).

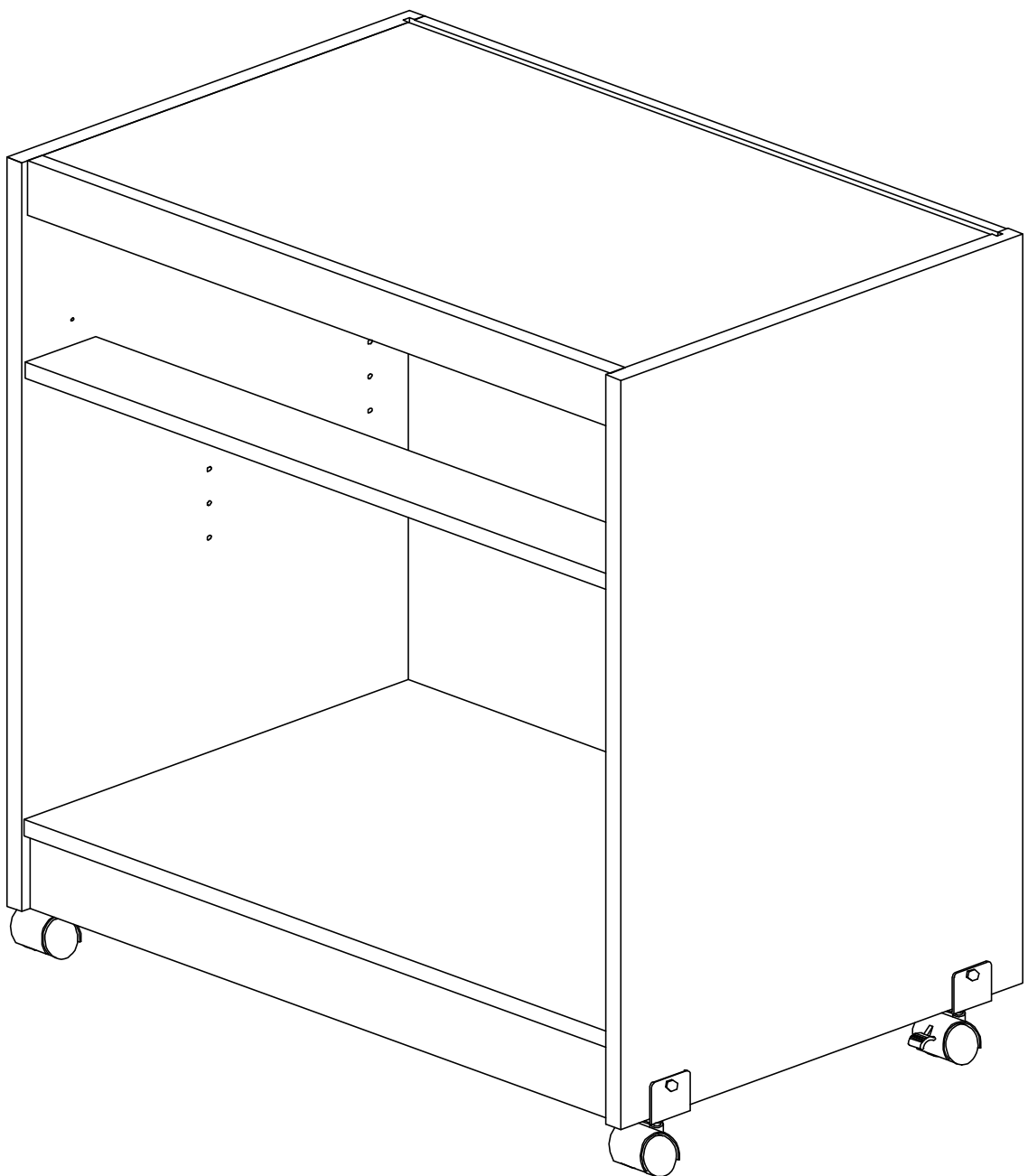


Assembly Instruction Step 6

Take Caster **O1** & **O2** (One By One). Slot The "U" Metal Part Of Caster Onto The Bottom Edge (At Each Corner Area), Insert And Push The Caster's Screw Thru From Outside To Inside To Inside, Then Tighten The Nut As Shown For All 4 Casters.

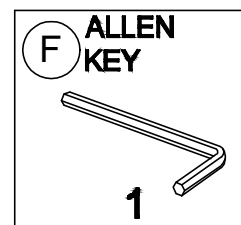
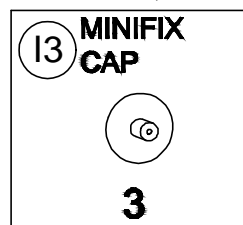
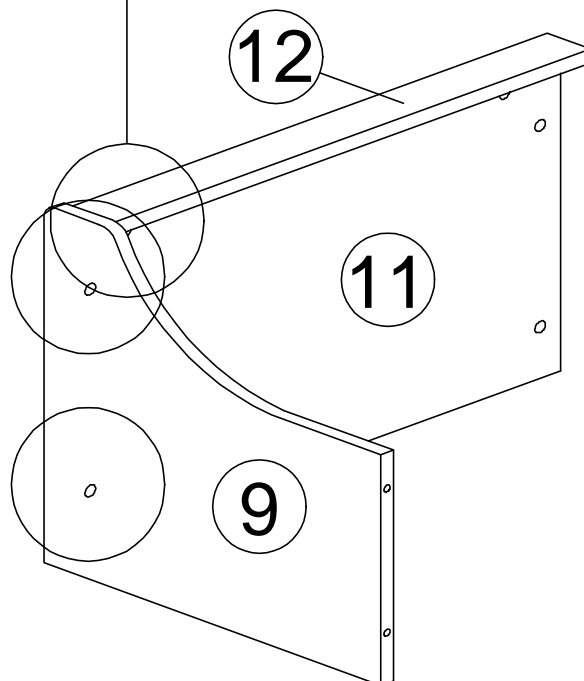
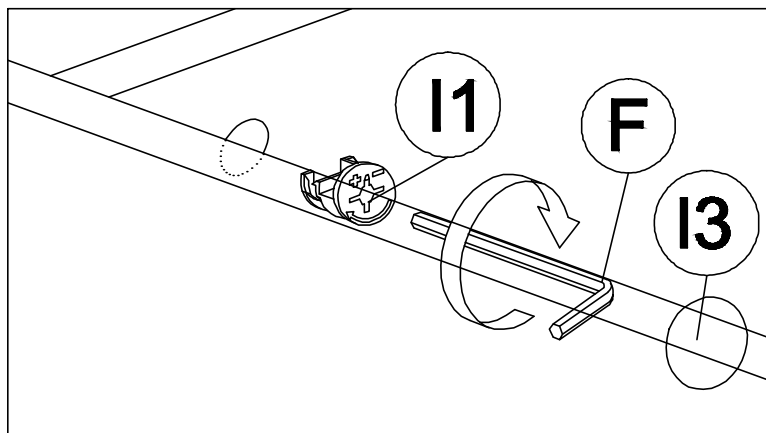

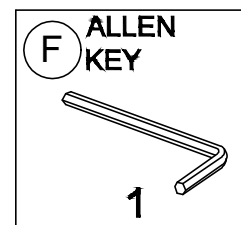
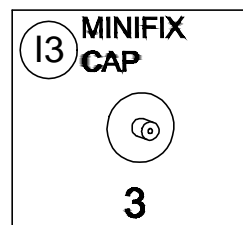
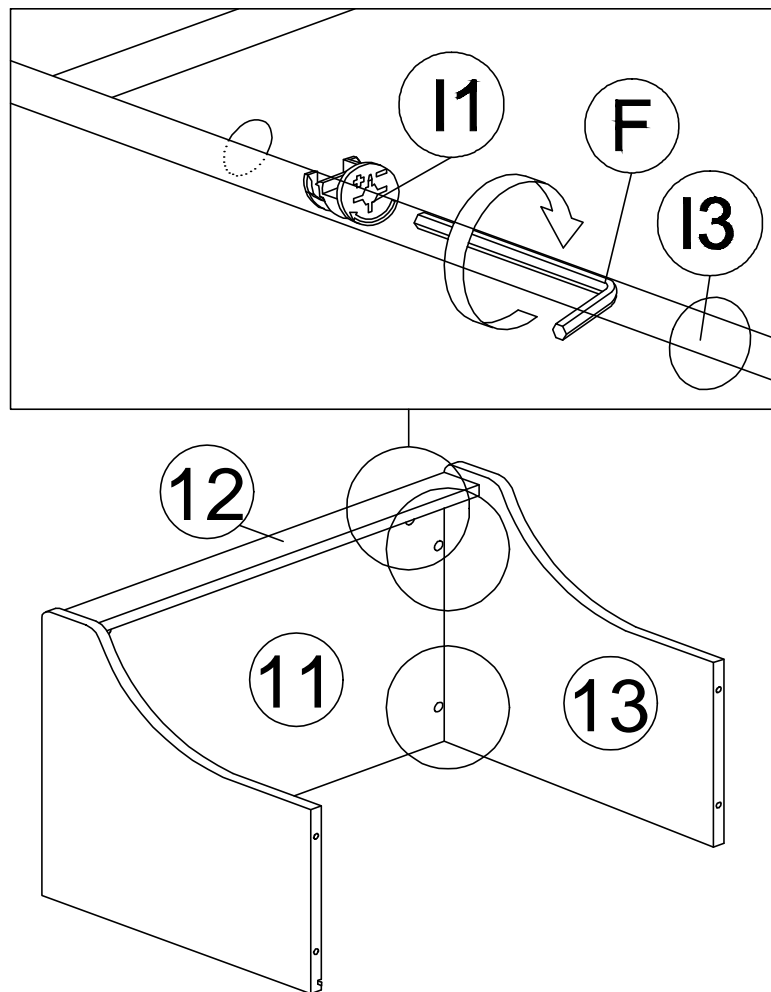
Assembly Instruction Step 7

Fix Panel (11,12) Onto Panel (9) By Inserting Minifix (I1) Into Panel (11,12) 's L-thru Holes And Using Allen Key (F) To Tighten It After That Insert Minifix Cap (I3).

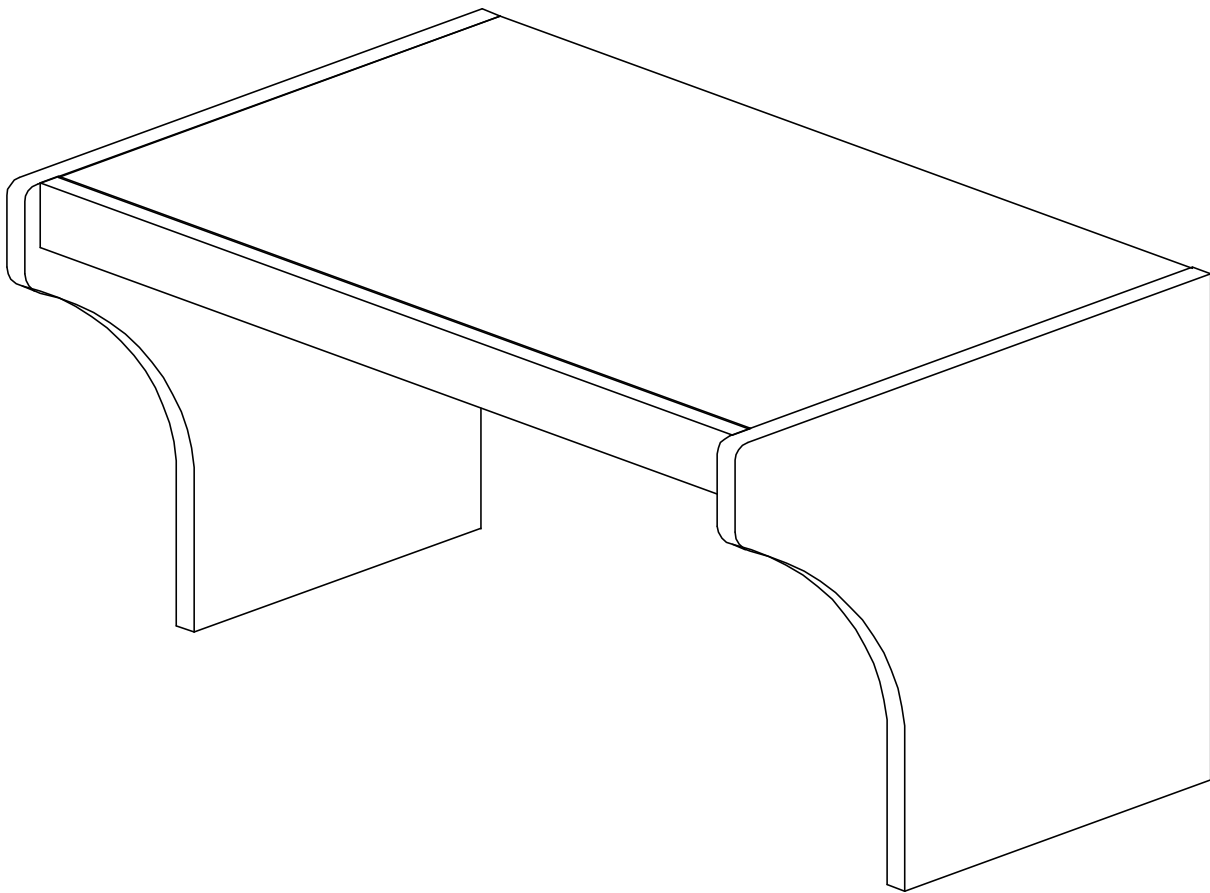


Assembly Instruction Step 8

Fix Panel (11,12) Onto Panel (13) By Inserting Minifix (I1) Into Panel (11,12) 's L-thru Holes And Using Allen Key (F) To Tighten It After That Insert Minifix Cap (I3).

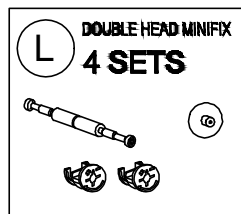
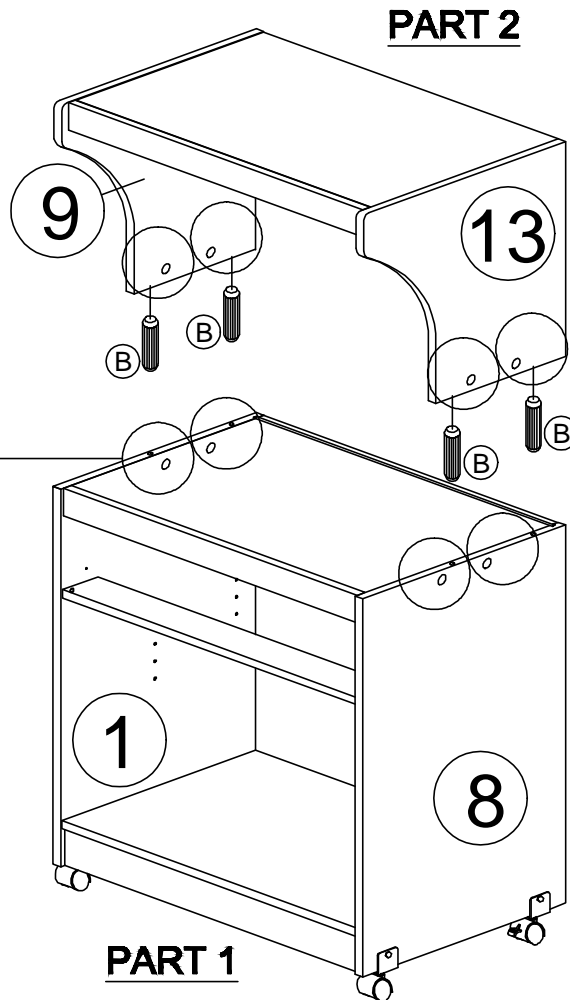
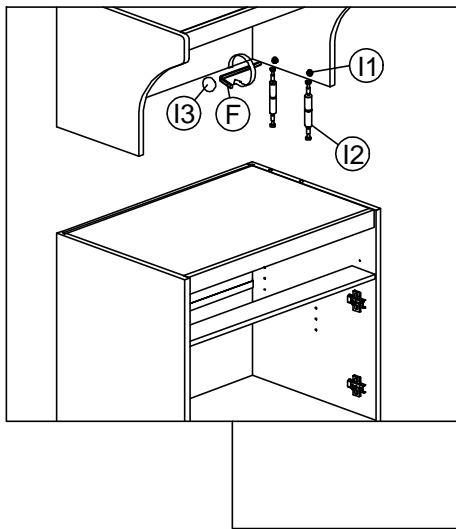

Assembly Instruction Step 9

Insert Dowel (**B**) And Double Head Minifix (**L1**) Into Panel (**9,13**) And Panel (**1,8**) And Minifix (**L2**) Into Panel (**9,13**) And Panel (**1,8**)'s L 'thru Holes And Using Allen Key (**F**) To Tighten It After That Insert Minifix Cap (**L3**).



Assembly Instruction Step 10

At Face Down Position, Place Back Panel (5,10) Onto The Back Of Main Unit, And Align It Properly For Nailing. Use Hammer To Nail The Nails One By One On The Line Drawer And At Center Of 4 Side Edges. Gap Between 2 Nails Is About 100mm For All.
