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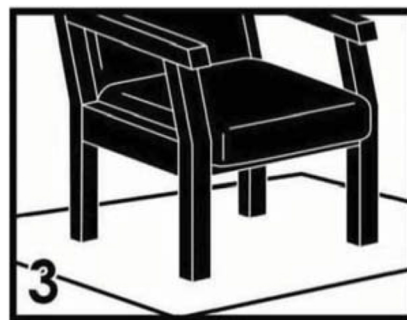
BASIC ASSEMBLY TECHNIQUES



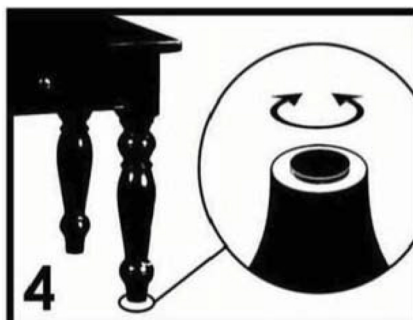
When lock or spring washer is used in an assembly, please make sure the lock or spring washer is placed between the larger flat washer and the head of the screw or bolt.



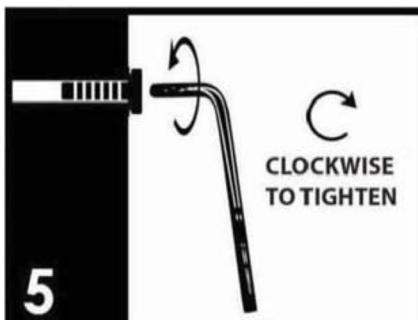
Position each part correctly and insert screws or bolts into their respective holes by hand tighten or using the proper hand tool. Only tighten when step is completed or when instructed to do so.



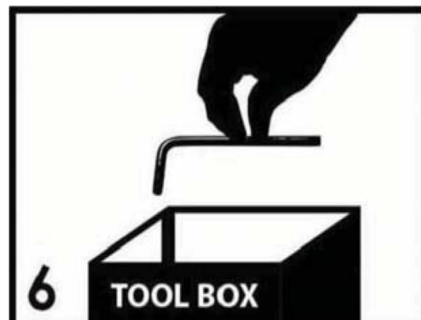
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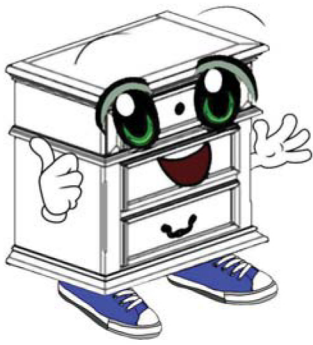


Save the instructions and store the Allen wrench or any supplied tool for later maintenance. After two weeks, check and tighten any loose hardware and repeat again every six months thereafter.

1. Prepare 8 bolt assemblies by first inserting a lock washer (#B) onto the bolt (#A) then a flat washer (#C) onto that same bolt (#A).

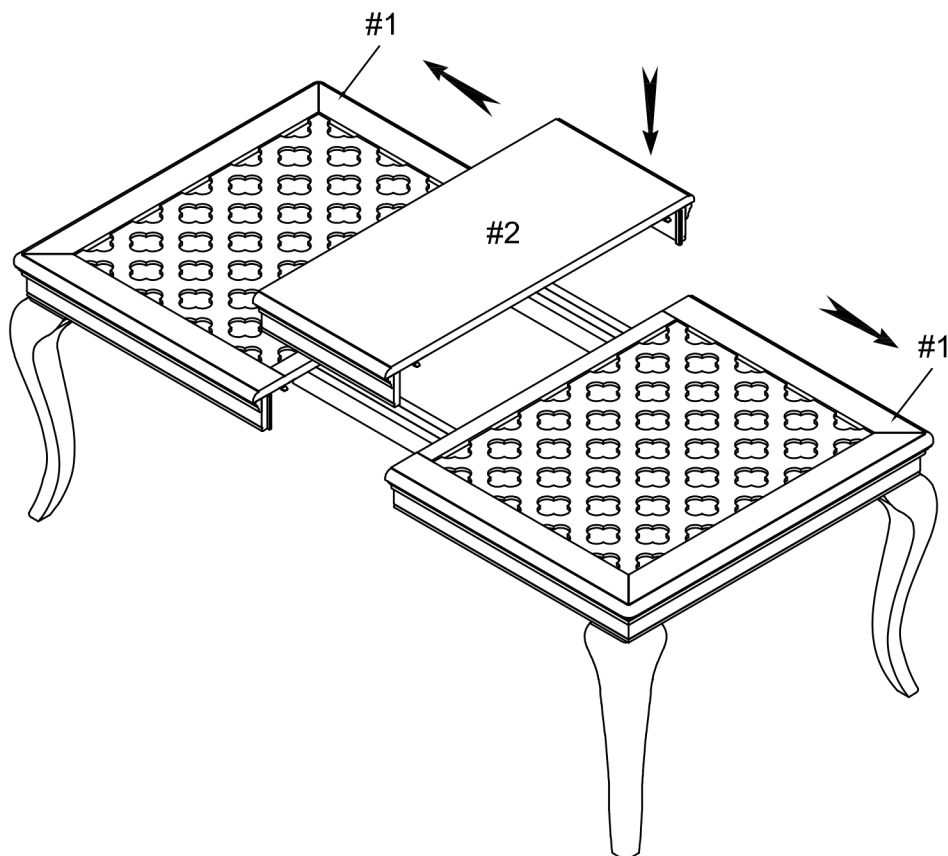


2. Place the table top (#1) face down onto a protected surface, then align the legs (#3) to each corner. Insert 2 bolt assemblies into each corner and secure using the Allen wrench (#D).

3. Unlock the latches located underneath the table top (#1).

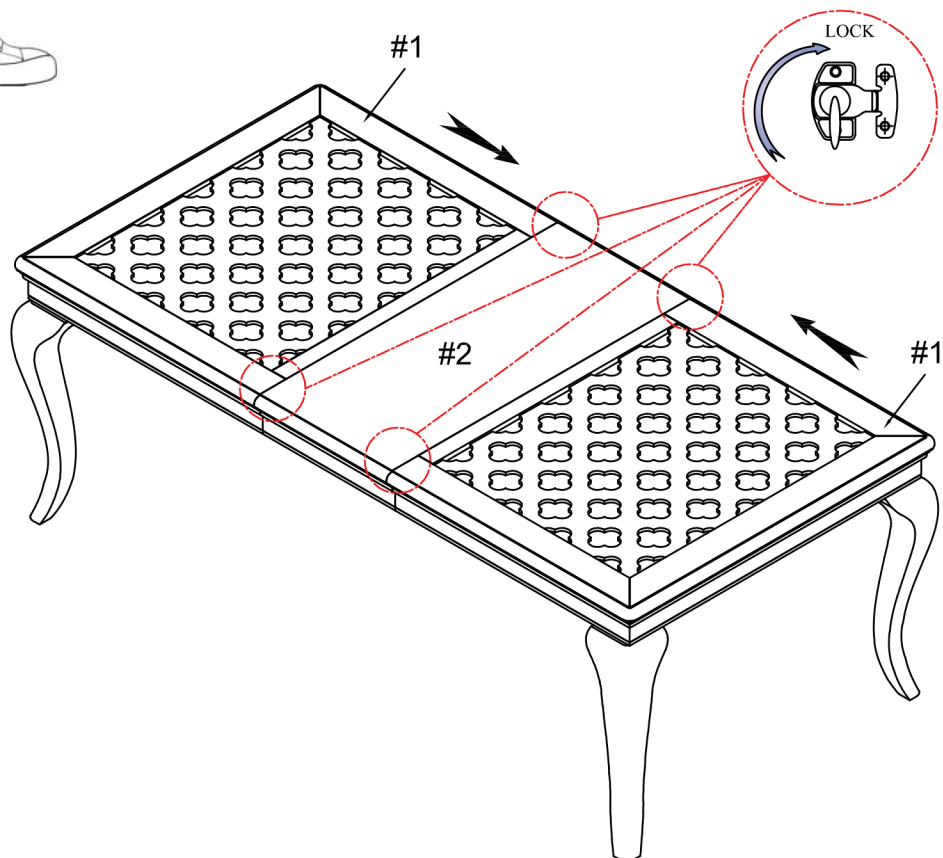


Slide each end of the table outwards, then place the leaf (#2).

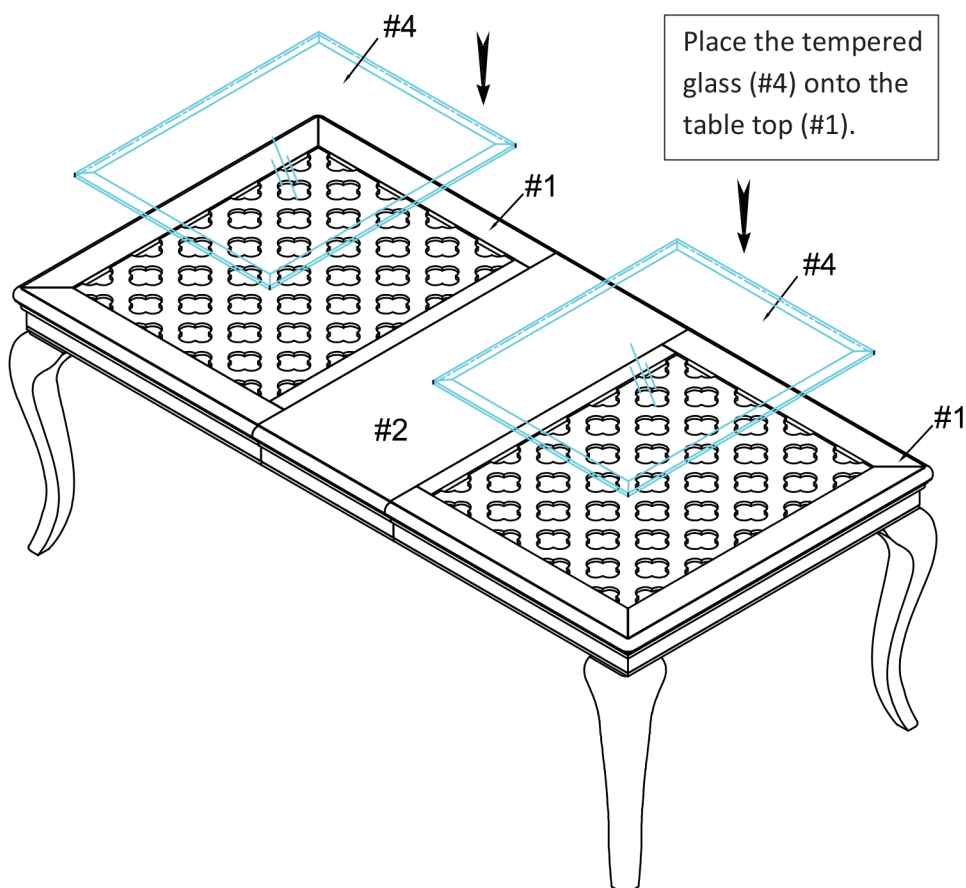




Slide each end of the table inwards, then secure the latches.

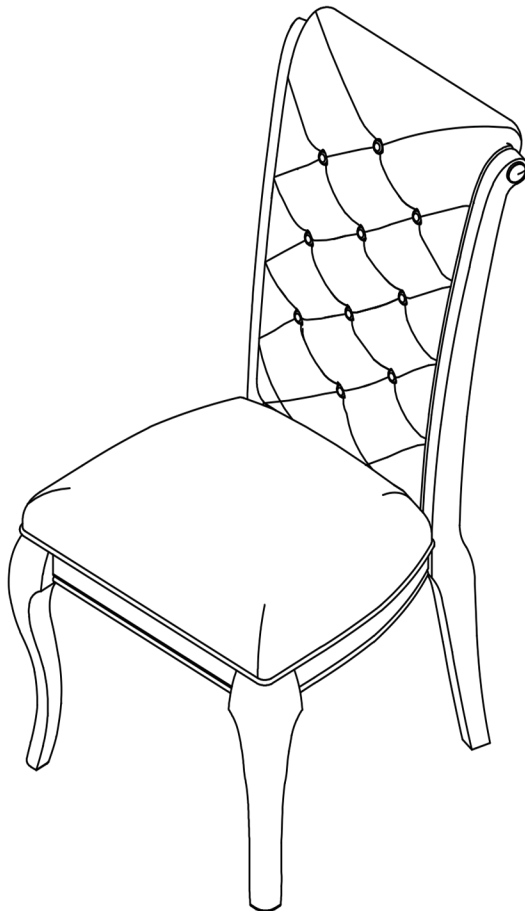


Place the tempered glass (#4) onto the table top (#1).

2. Prepare a bolt assembly by first inserting a lock washer (#D) onto the bolt (#A) then a flat washer (#E) onto that same bolt (#A).

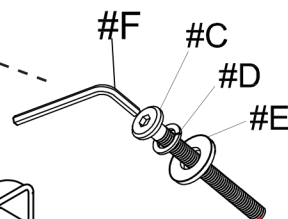
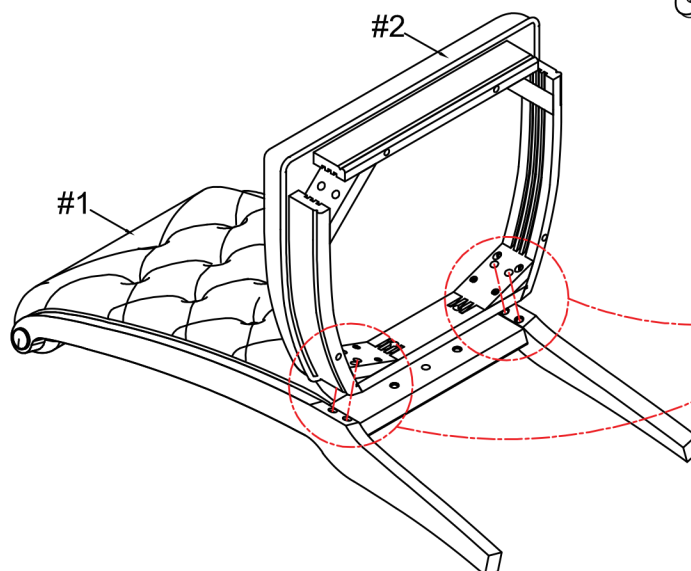
3. Align the seat (#2) to the hole along the backrest w/legs (#1), then insert the bolt assembly. Secure using the Allen wrench.

1. Prepare 4 bolt assemblies by first inserting a lock washer (#D) onto the bolt (#C) then a flat washer (#E) onto that same bolt (#C).

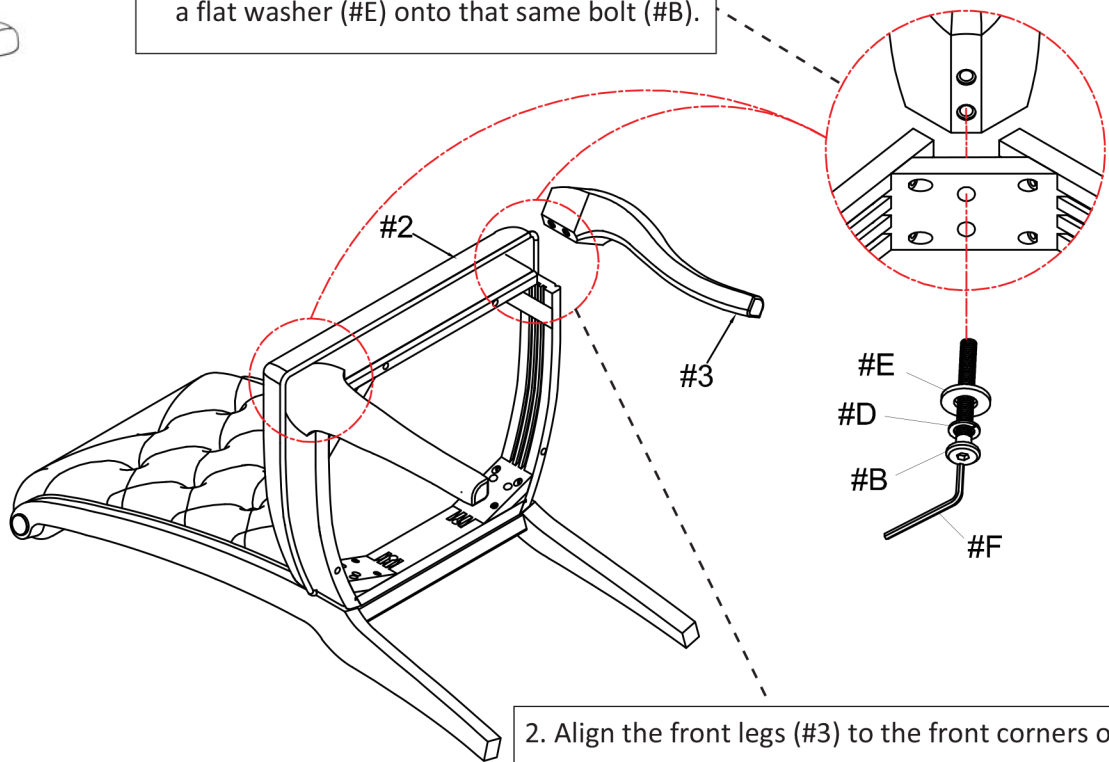


2. Insert 2 bolt assemblies into each back corner of the seat (#2), Secure using the Allen wrench.

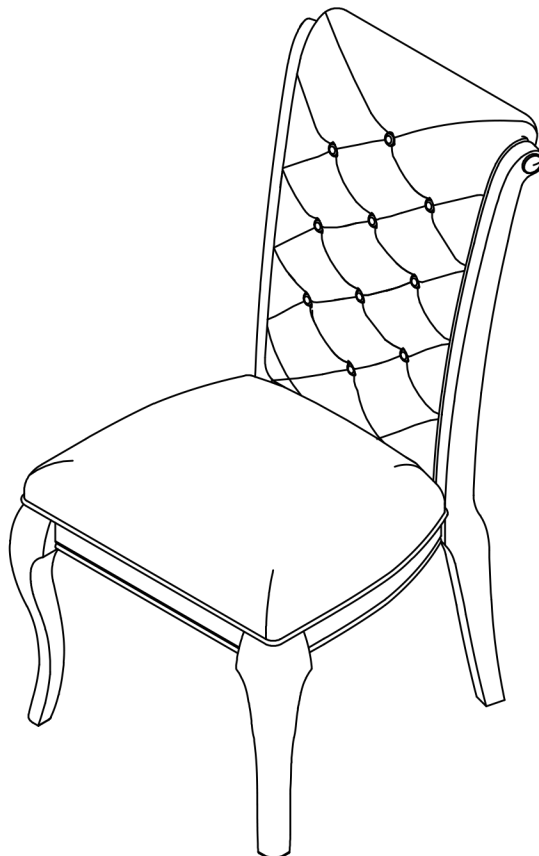

2. Align the front legs (#3) to the front corners of the seat (#2), then insert 2 bolt assemblies into each front corner. Secure using the Allen wrench.
