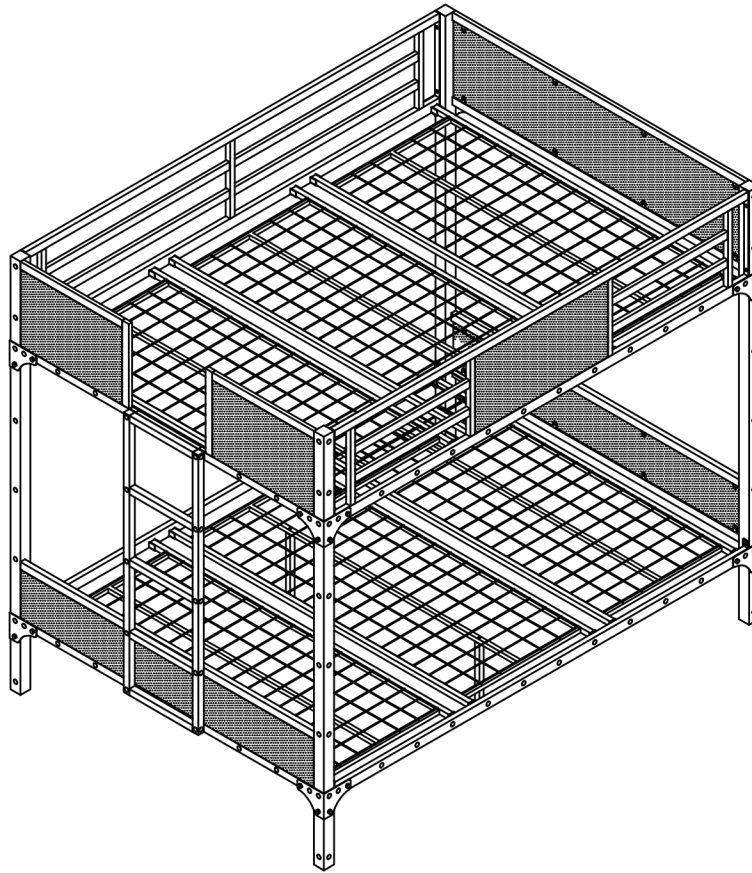


Assembly Instructions

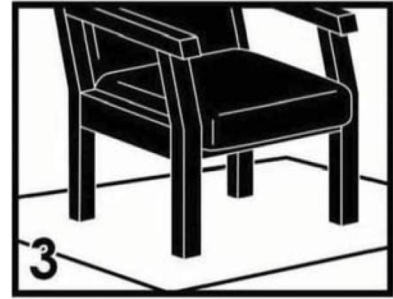
BASIC ASSEMBLY TECHNIQUES



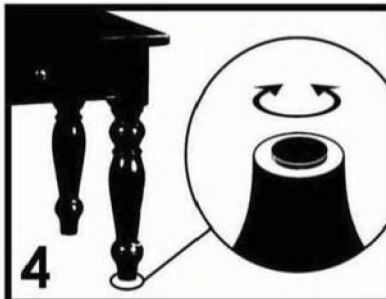
1 When lock or spring washer is used in an assembly, please make sure the lock or spring washer is placed between the larger flat washer and the head of the screw or bolt.



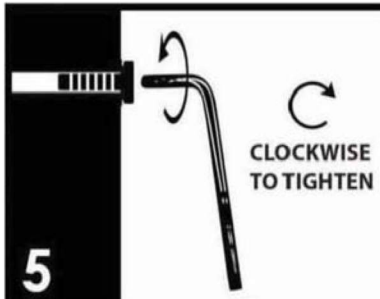
2 Position each part correctly and insert screws or bolts into their respective holes by hand tighten or using the proper hand tool. Only tighten when step is completed or when instructed to do so.



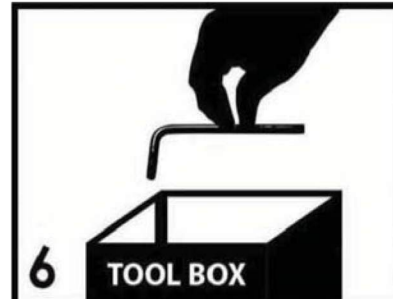
3 Use cardboard or carpet area when assembling furniture to prevent scratches. Make sure the furniture rests on a flat and level surface with each leg evenly touching the floor.



4 Some furniture comes with height adjustment knobs underneath each leg. To lower or to raise each leg, you need to turn clockwise or counterclockwise, respectively.



5 Make sure all parts are properly aligned, then use the appropriate hand tool to completely tighten the bolts or screws. Do not use power tools and do not overtighten.

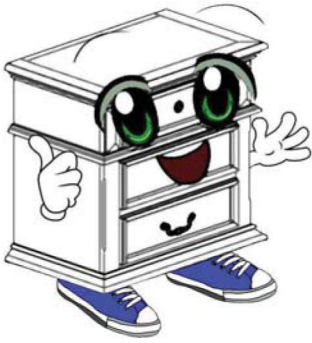


6 Save the instructions and store the Allen wrench or any supplied tool for later maintenance. After two weeks, check and tighten any loose hardware and repeat again every six months thereafter.

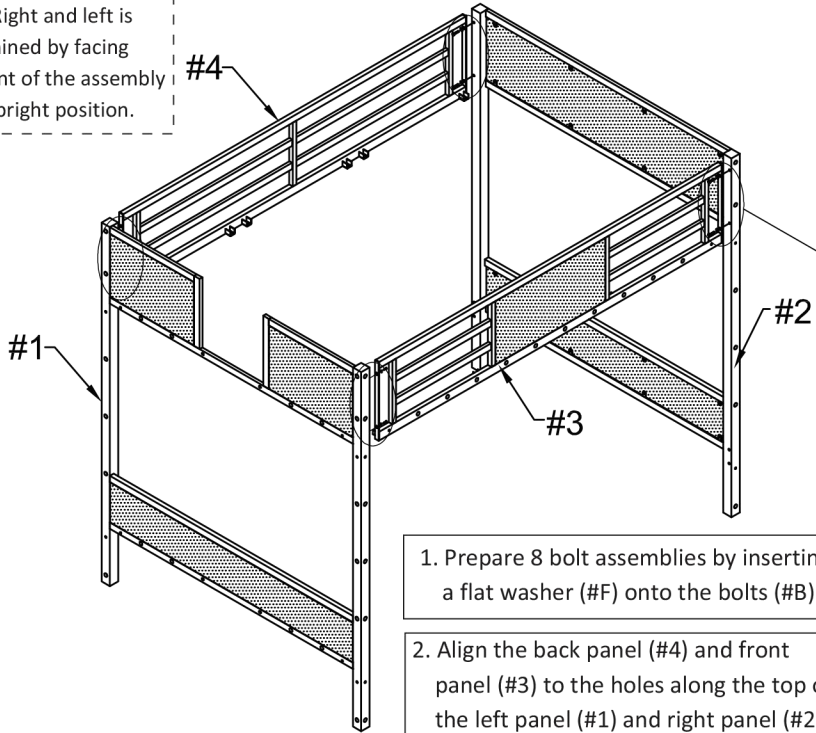


ASSEMBLY

Do not fully tighten all bolts until assembly is complete. This will help all parts to assemble properly.

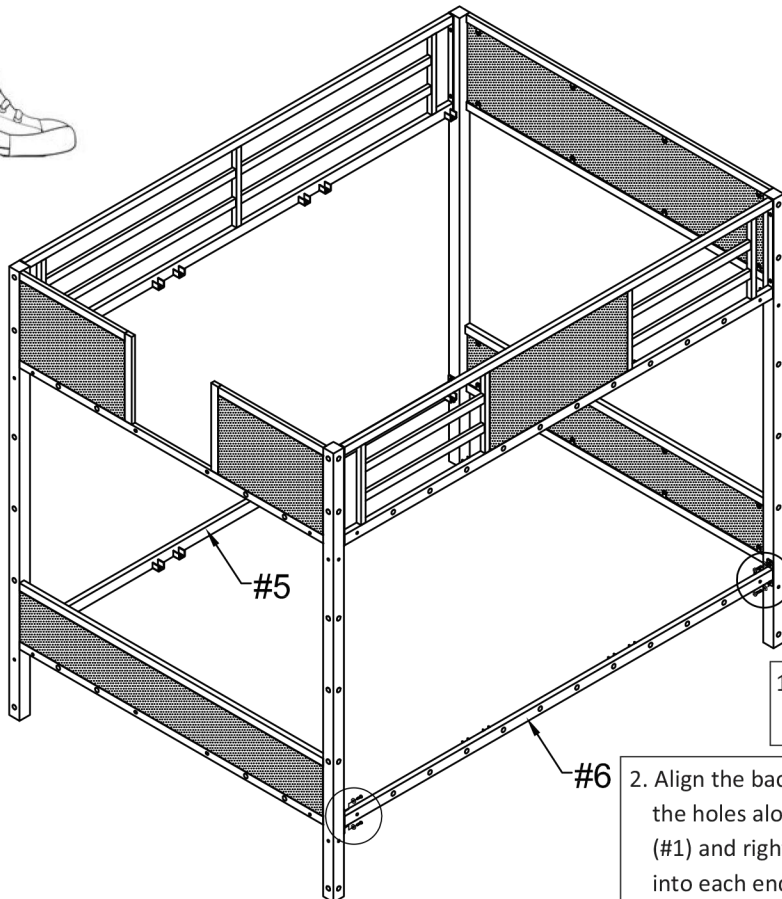
Note: Right and left is determined by facing the front of the assembly in its upright position.



1. Prepare 8 bolt assemblies by inserting a flat washer (#F) onto the bolts (#B).
2. Align the back panel (#4) and front panel (#3) to the holes along the top of the left panel (#1) and right panel (#2), then insert 2 bolt assemblies into each end and secure using the Allen wrench.

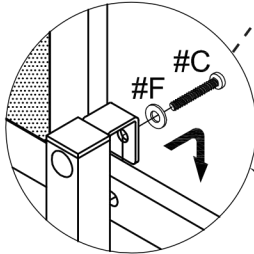


1. Prepare 8 bolt assemblies by inserting a flat washer (#F) onto the bolts (#B).
2. Align the back side rail (#5) and front side rail (#6) to the holes along the bottom sides of the left panel (#1) and right panel (#2), then insert 2 bolt assemblies into each end and secure using the Allen wrench (#G).

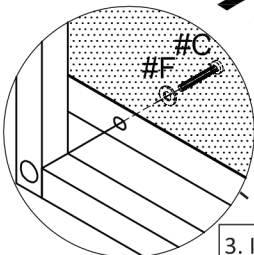


2. Hook the top of the ladder (#7) to the left panel (#1), then insert a bolt assembly into the holes. Secure using the Allen wrench.

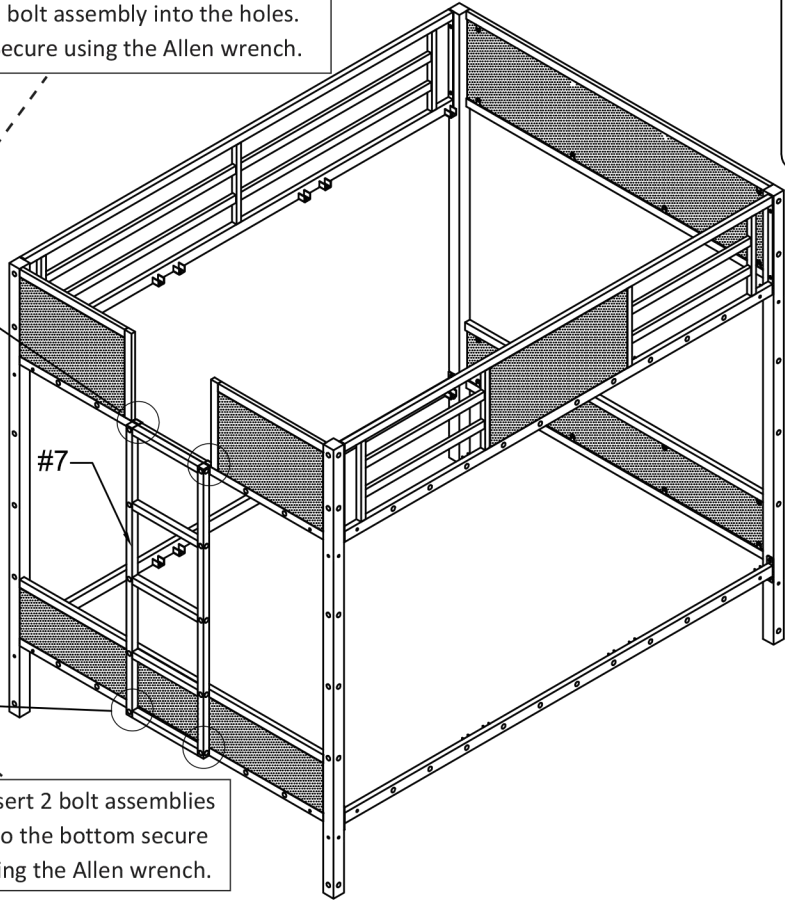

1. Prepare 4 bolt assemblies by inserting a flat washer (#F) onto the bolts (#C).

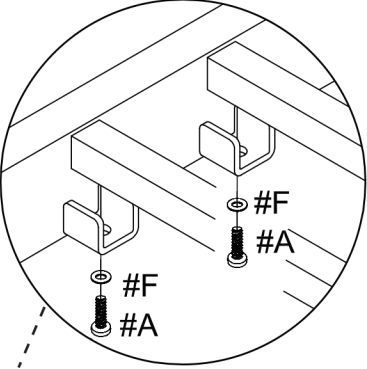


3. Insert 2 bolt assemblies into the bottom rail using the Allen wrench.

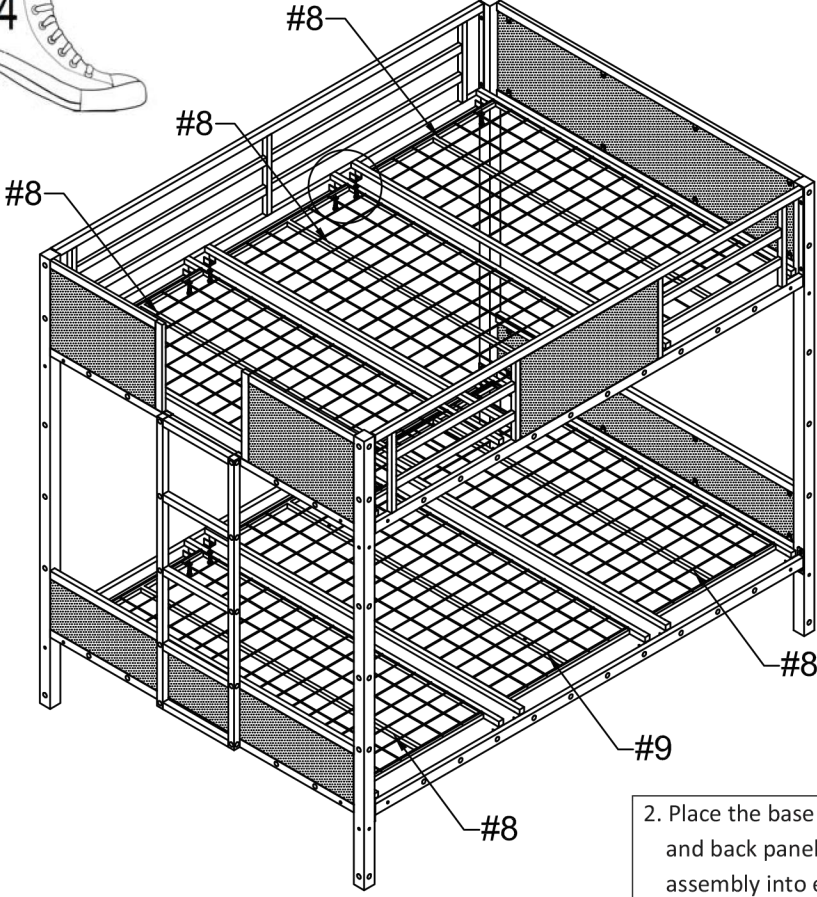


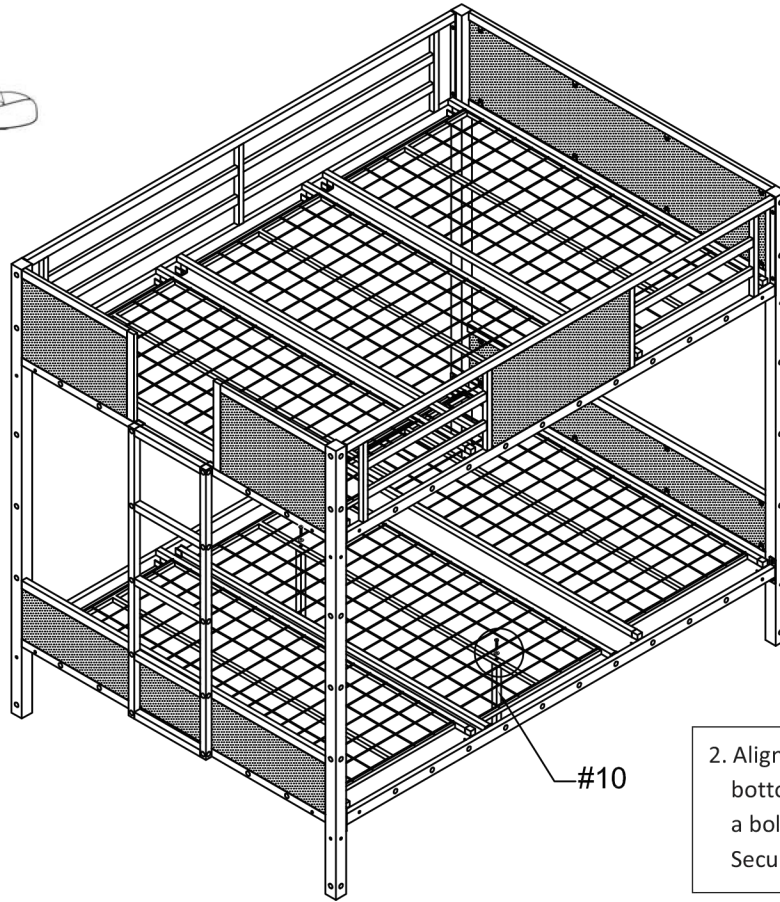

1. Prepare 24 bolt assemblies by inserting a flat washer (#F) onto the bolts (#A).



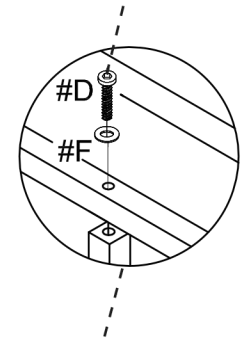
2. Place the base frames (#8) onto the slots along the front and back panels/rails, then from beneath insert a bolt assembly into each end. Secure using the Allen wrench (#G).



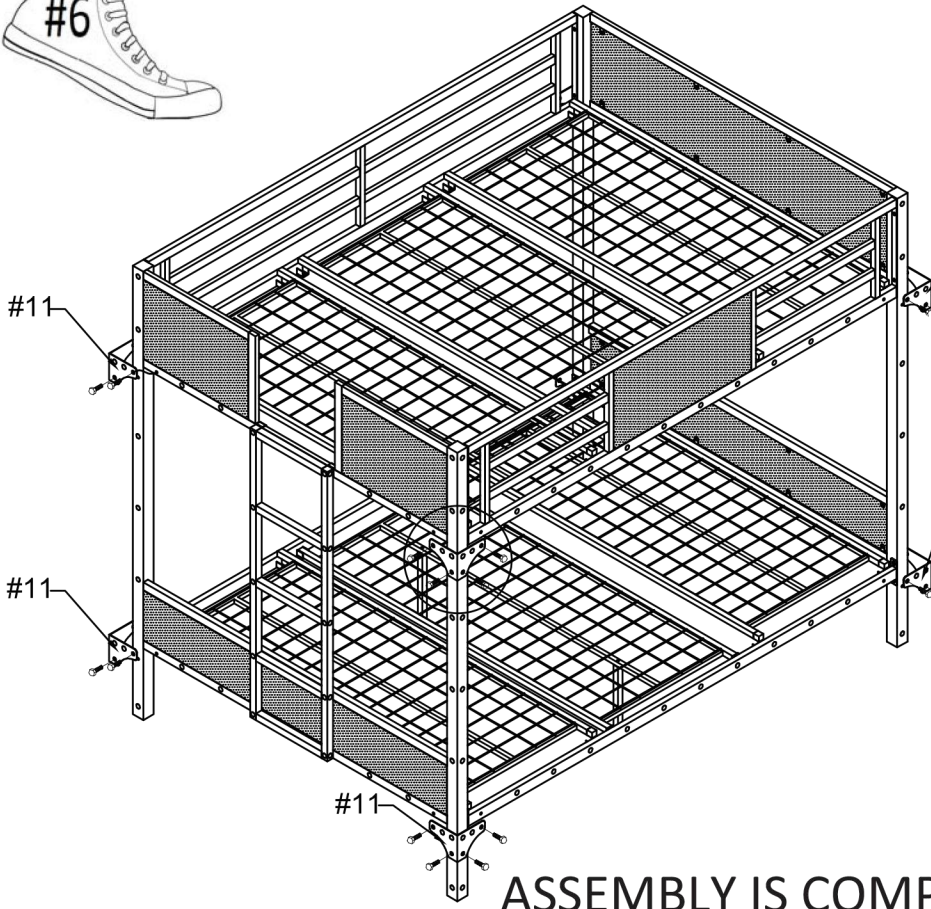




1. Prepare 2 bolt assemblies by inserting a flat washer (#F) onto the bolts (#D).

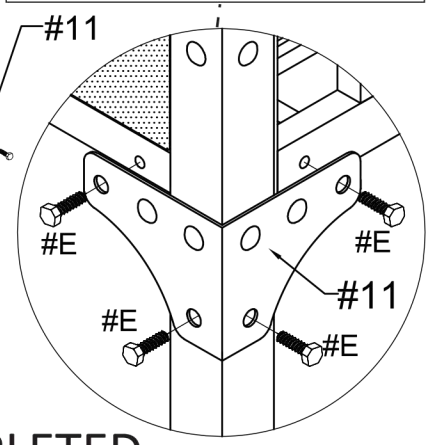


2. Align the top of support legs (#10) to the bottom center base frame, then insert a bolt assembly into each from above. Secure using the Allen wrench (#G).

Align the garnish (#11) to each corner and insert 4 bolts (#E) into each garnish. Secure using the wrench (#H).



ASSEMBLY IS COMPLETED

Safety Warnings

1. Follow the information on the warnings appearing on the upper bunk end structure and on the carton . Do not remove warning label from bed.
2. Always use the recommended size mattress or mattress support, or both, to help prevent the likelihood of entrapment or falls.
3. Surface of mattress must be at least 5 in (127mm) below the upper edge of guardrails .
4. Do not allow children under 6 years of age to use the upper bunk.
5. Periodically check and ensure that the guardrail, ladder, and other components are in their proper position, free from damage, and that all connectors are tight .
6. Do not allow horseplay on or under the bed and prohibit jumping on the bed.
7. Always use the ladder for entering and leaving the upper bunk.
8. Do not use substitute parts, Contact manufacturer or dealer for replacement parts.
9. Use of a night light may provide added safety precaution for a child using the upper bunk.
10. Always use guardrails on both long sides of the upper bunk.
If the bunk bed will be placed next to the wall, the guardrail that runs the full length of the bed should be placed against the wall to prevent entrapment between the bed and the wall.
11. The use of water or sleep flotation mattress is prohibited .
12. Keep these instructions for future reference.
13. Use only mattress which is (74"-75")X(53-54")X6" on upper bunk and for bottom bunk required (74"-75")X(53"-54") X8" mattress.
14. Prohibit more than one person on upper bunk.
15. Maximum total weight is not to exceed 400 lbs. on the upper bunk.

STRANGULATION HAZARD:

Never attach or hang items to any part of the bunk bed that are not designed for use with the bed, for example, but not limited to, hooks, belts, and jumpropes.
