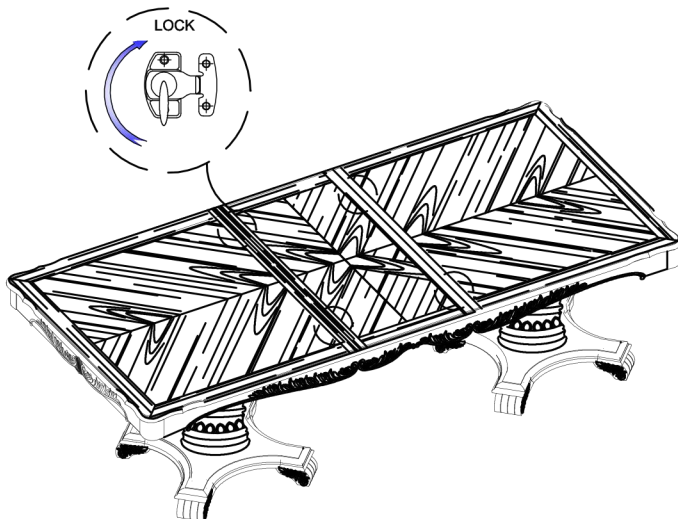
Unlock locks underneath the tabletop to spread ends out and insert the leaf (#2).
