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Disassembly Instructions

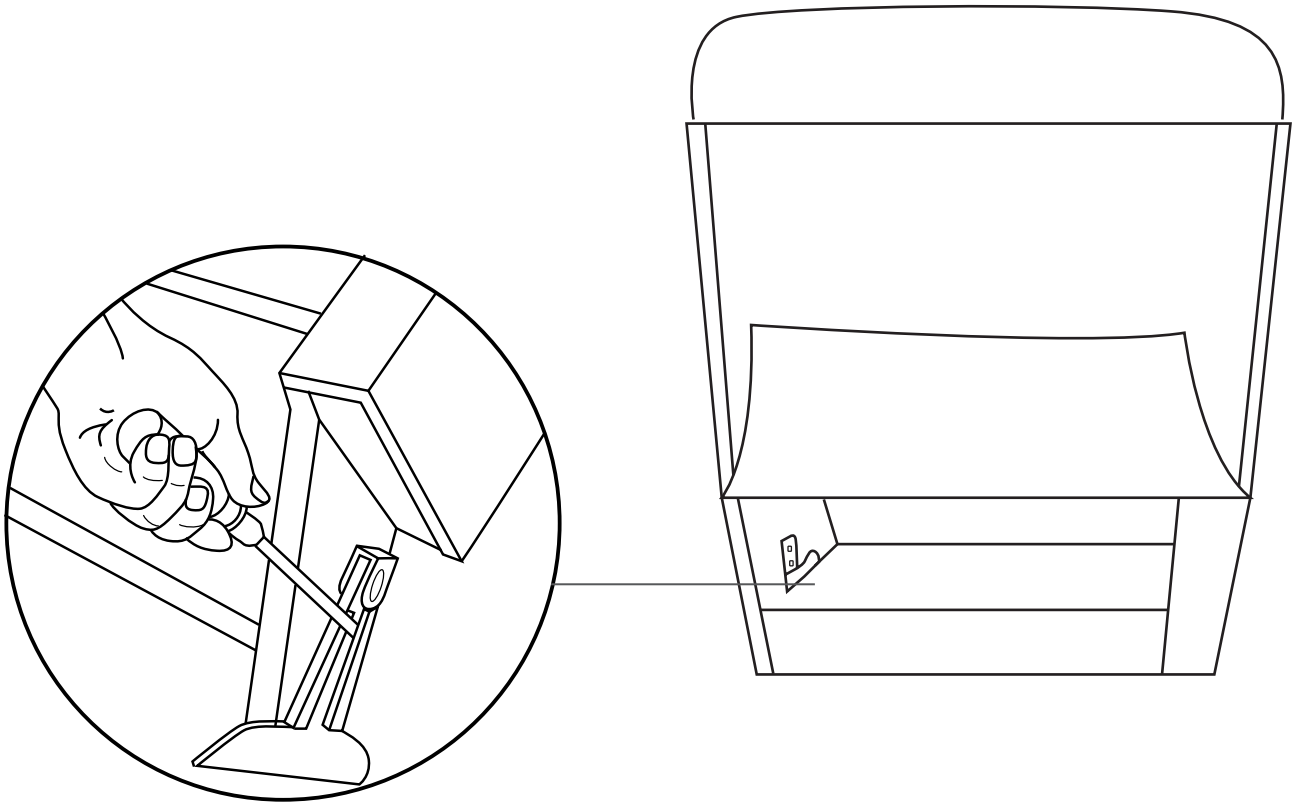
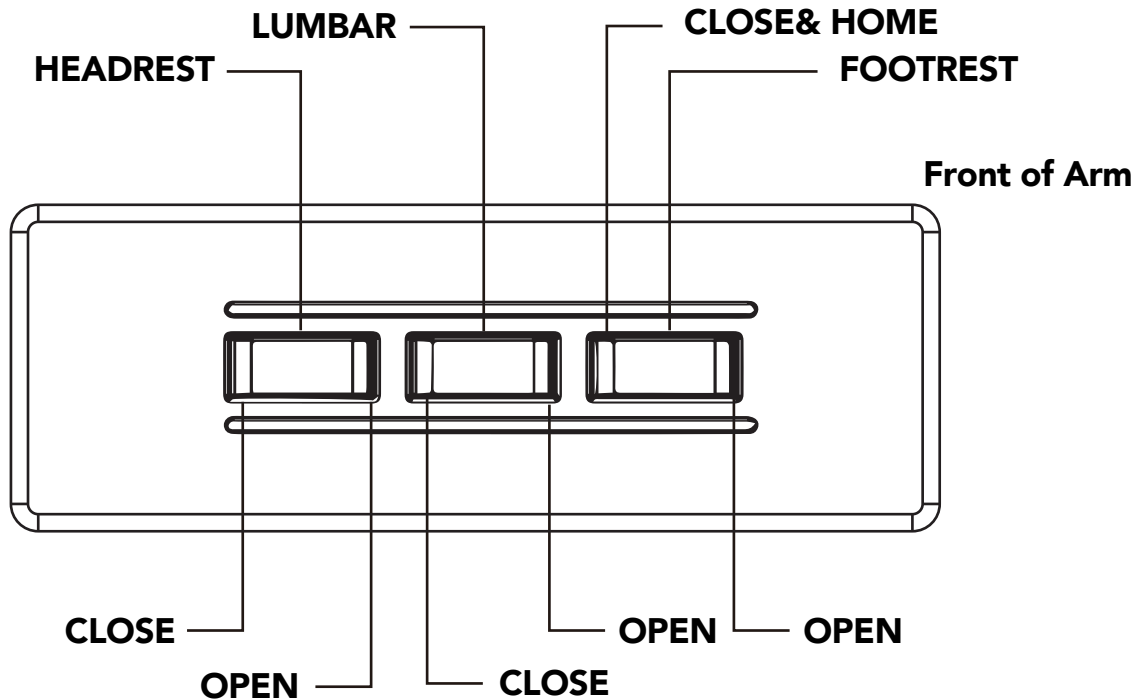

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Do not allow children to play on or operate this power mechanized equipment



Care should always be taken to assure there is nothing in the path of the mechanism before and during operation.

To recline: Sit on the furniture, and press the front of the button closest to the footrest to smoothly raise the footrest and recline to any position. To lower the footrest and return to an upright position, press the back side of the button closest to the footrest.

To adjust headrest: Press the front of the button closest to the backrest to smoothly raise and adjust the headrest to any position. To lower the headrest and return it to its original position, press the back side of the button closest to the backrest.

To adjust lumbar support: Press the front of the center button to smoothly raise and adjust the lumbar support to any position. To lower the lumbar support and return it to its original position, press the back side of the center button.

To close all: To simultaneously return the headrest, footrest, and lumbar support to their original positions, press and hold the back side of the button closest to the footrest.

- 1** Remove the zip tie holding the foam bag with the Power Transformer, its cord and the remote on the left. (See Figure 1.1)



- 2** Attach the Back (1) to the Seat (2). Ensure the latches fit well. (See Figure 2.1)
Take out the remote from the side pocket of the chair. Remove the remote from the plastic bag and connect it to the female plug located in the outside pocket of the chair. (See Figure 2.2)

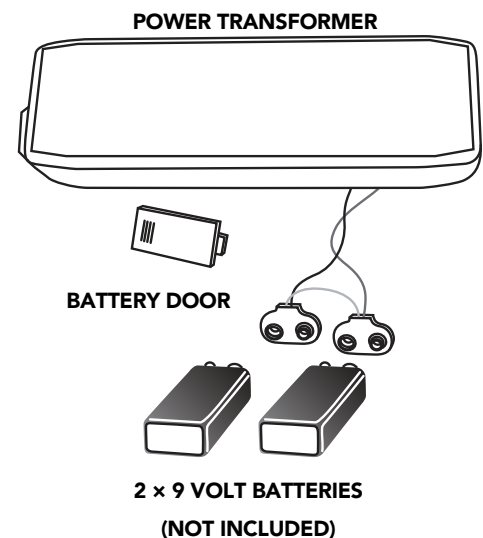
INSTALLATION OF BACK-UP BATTERIES

2 × 9 Volt back-up batteries will lift the chair from the reclined position to the seating position **one cycle** in case of a power failure. If a power failure occurs and the chair is cycled, the 2 × 9 Volts batteries will need to be replaced.

1. Removed the sliding door on the side of the transformer to locate the 2 × 9 Volt batteries.
2. Pull out the 2 × 9 Volt batteries and replace with new batteries.
3. Replace door on the transformer.
4. **Batteries not included.**

Instructions for use

Always purchase the correct size and grade of battery most suitable for the intended use. Replace all batteries of a set at the same time. Clean the battery contacts and also those of the device prior to battery installation. Ensure the batteries are installed correctly with regard to polarity (+ and -). Remove batteries from equipment that is not to be used for an extended period of time. Remove used batteries promptly.



INSTALLATION OF BACK-UP BATTERIES

4-9 Volt back-up batteries will lift the chair from the reclined position to the seating position **one cycle** in case of a power failure occurs and the chair is cycled, the 4-9 volts batteries will need to be replaced.

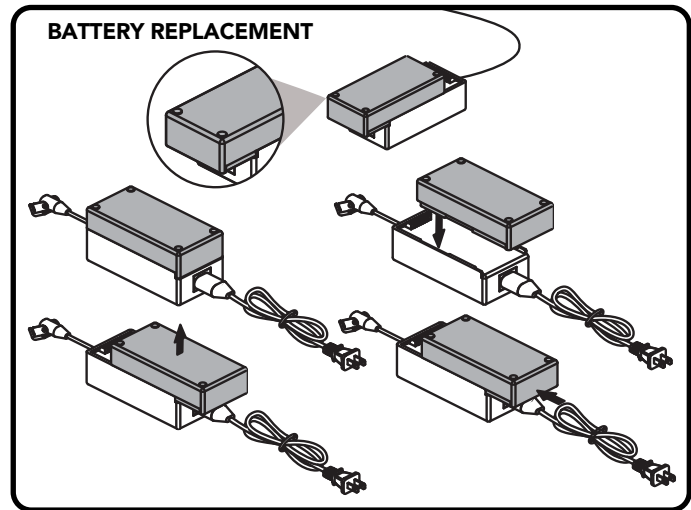
1. Remove the sliding door on the side of the transformer to locate the 4 × 9 Volt batteries.
2. Place the battery box on top of the external transformer with the securement grooves toward the external transformer.
3. Slide the battery box onto the external transformer until it clicks into place.

9V Emergency Backup

Provides temporary emergency power in the event of a power outage. Batteries not included. Replace batteries every 6 months to ensure proper function when needed.

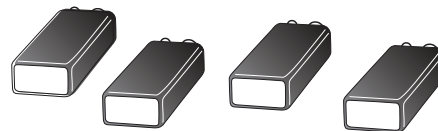
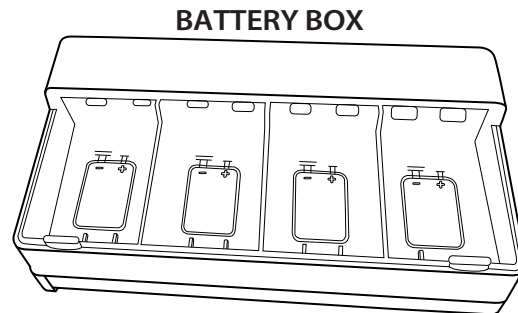

Follow these steps to replace the lithium-ion battery pack batteries:

1. Unplug the external transformer power cord from the electrical outlet.
2. Position the external transformer so that the lithium-ion battery is facing upward.
3. Gently bump with your hand the end of the lithium-ion battery pack to dislodge it from external transformer.
4. Slide the lithium-ion battery until it stops and then lift the lithium-ion battery off of the external transformer.
5. Place the new lithium-ion battery on top of the external transformer with the securement grooves toward the external transformer.
6. Slide the new lithium-ion battery onto the external transformer until it clicks into place.



4-9 VOLT BATTERIES
(Not Included)

NOTE: Remove the lithium-ion battery from the battery pack when your chair isn't being used for an extended period of time. The chair will draw power from the battery even when it is not in use.

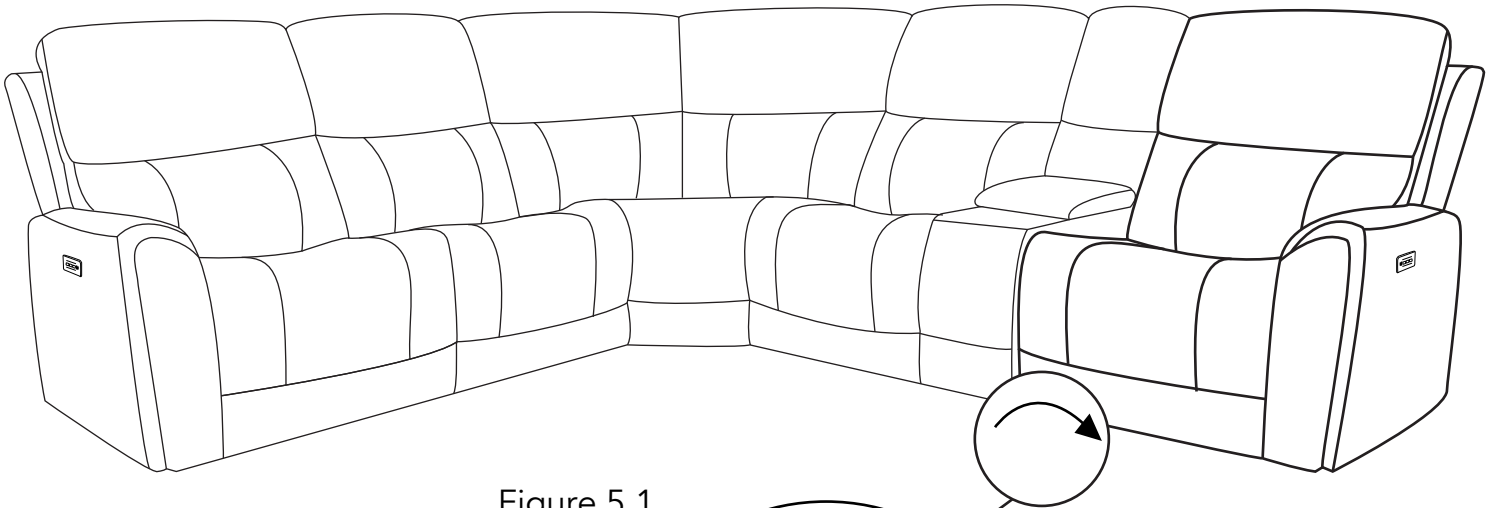

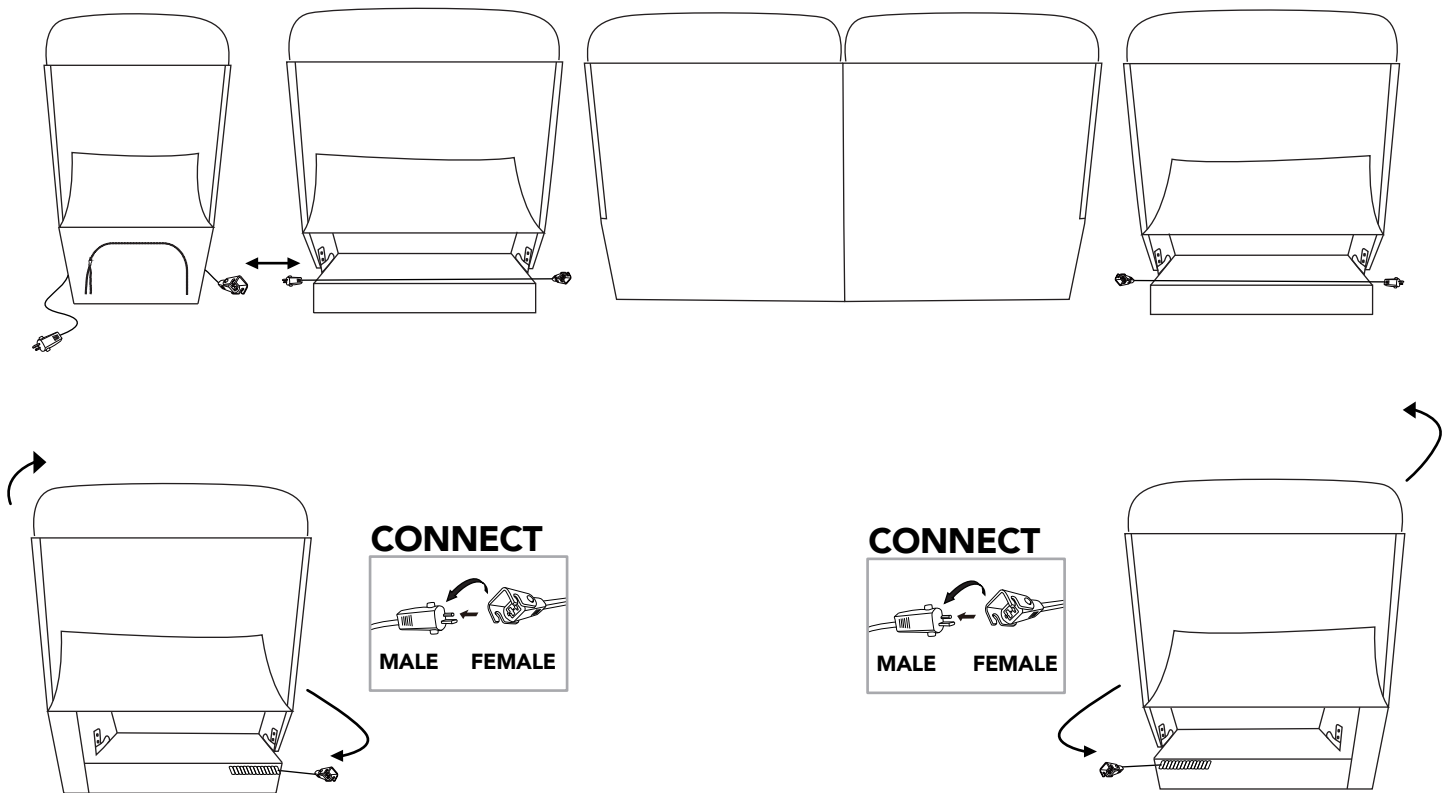

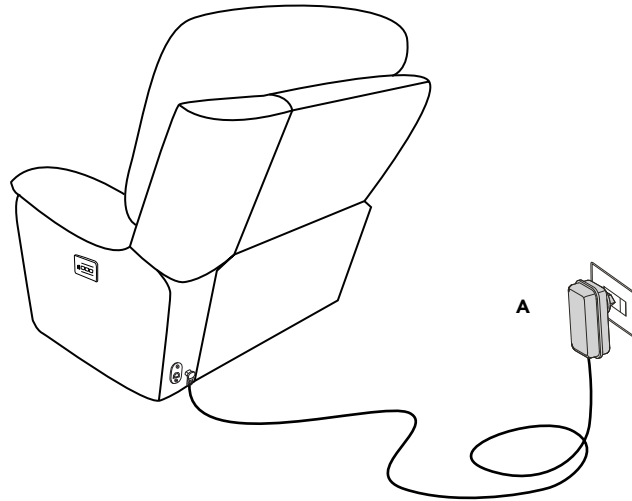

- 8** Fasten the back flap to the bottom of the furniture. (See Figure 8.1)

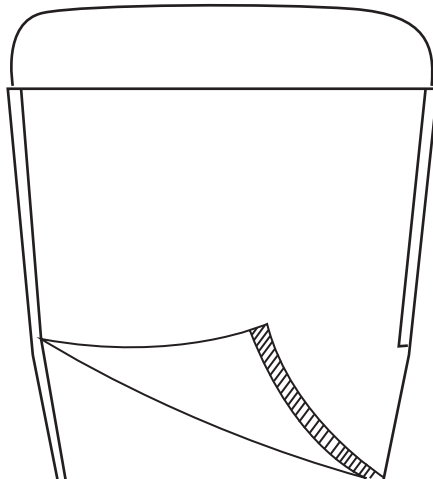

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Disassembly Instructions

To remove the back from the base, use a screwdriver pressing outward on the black tab in the metal receivers on both sides of the chair back and lift the back from the base of the chair to release. (See Figure 9.1)

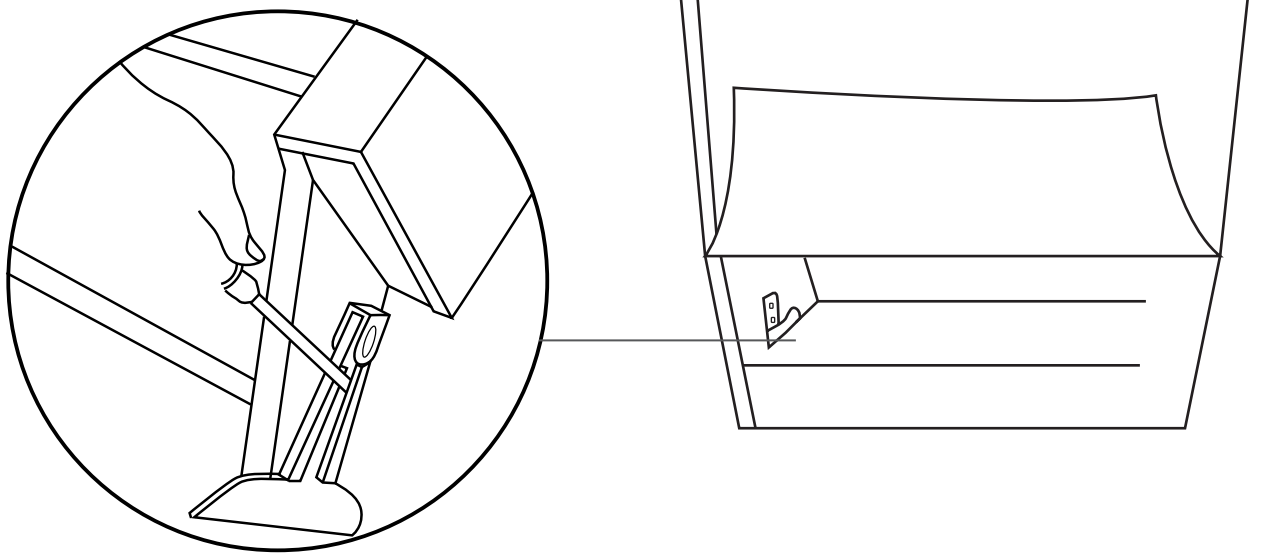
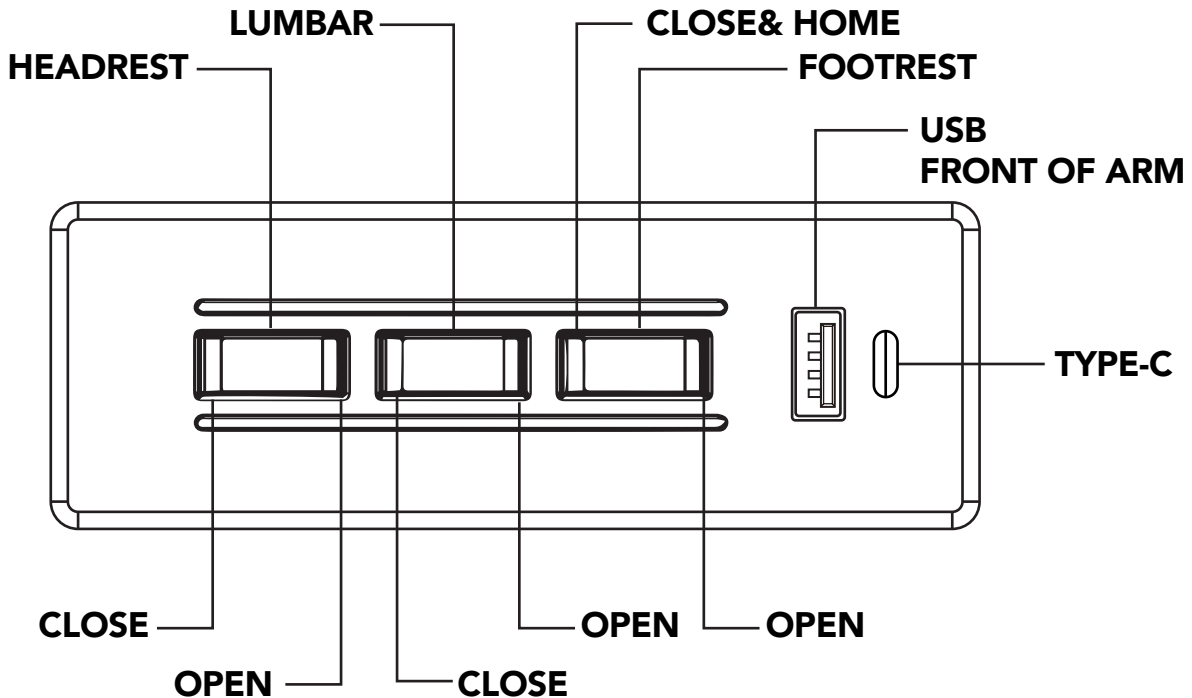

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

CAUTION: READ THE IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS BELOW BEFORE OPERATING YOUR POWER MECHANIZED EQUIPMENT

Care should always be taken to assure there is nothing in the path of the mechanism before and during operation.

To recline: Sit on the furniture, and press the front of the button closest to the footrest to smoothly raise the footrest and recline to any position. To lower the footrest and return to an upright position, press the back side of the button closest to the footrest.

To adjust headrest: Press the front of the button closest to the backrest to smoothly raise and adjust the headrest to any position. To lower the headrest and return it to its original position, press the back side of the button closest to the backrest.

To adjust lumbar support: Press the front of the center button to smoothly raise and adjust the lumbar support to any position. To lower the lumbar support and return it to its original position, press the back side of the center button.

To close all: To simultaneously return the headrest, footrest, and lumbar support to their original positions, press and hold the back side of the button closest to the footrest.
