FIRST: Join F+G to the bolts on the bottom of B, and lock them by inserting and turning the cam locks #3.



THEN: Do the same with panels C for the rest of the bolts.

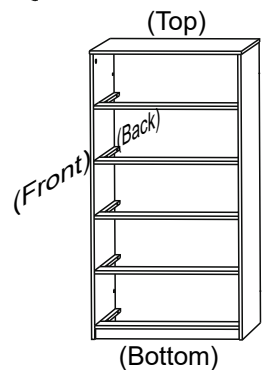
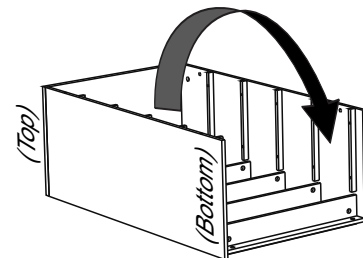
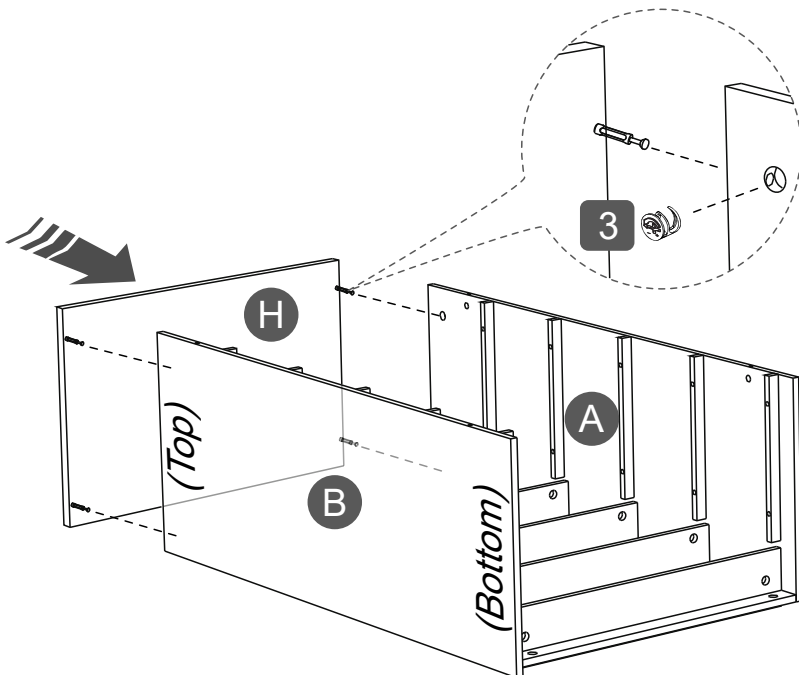


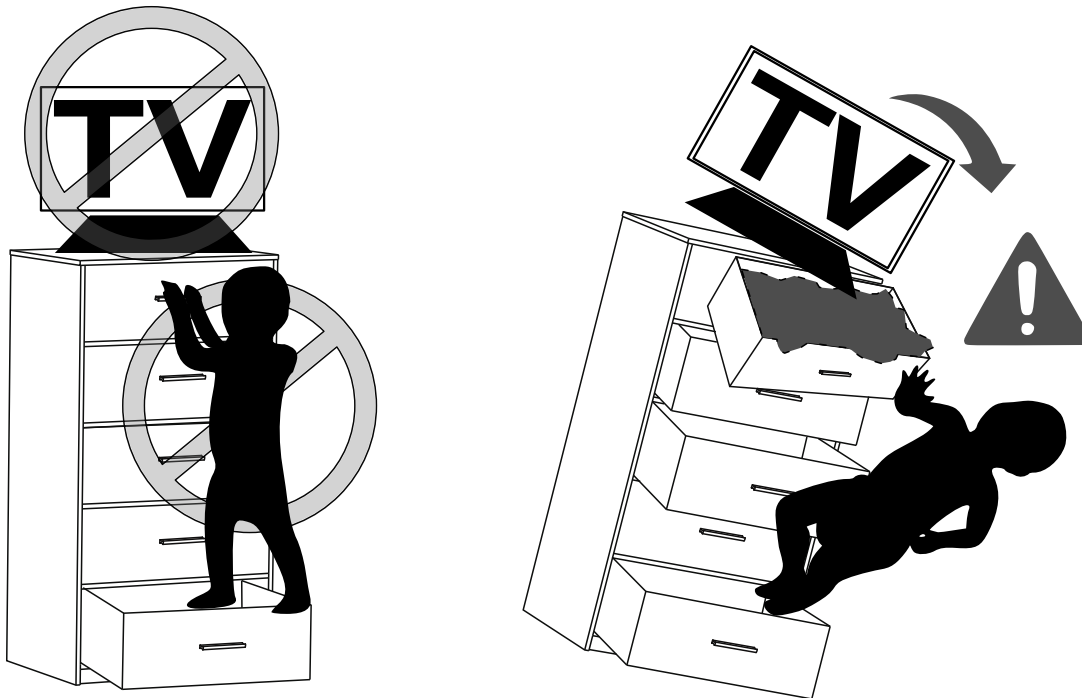
FIRST: Attach #2 to H.

LAST: Flip the unit upright.

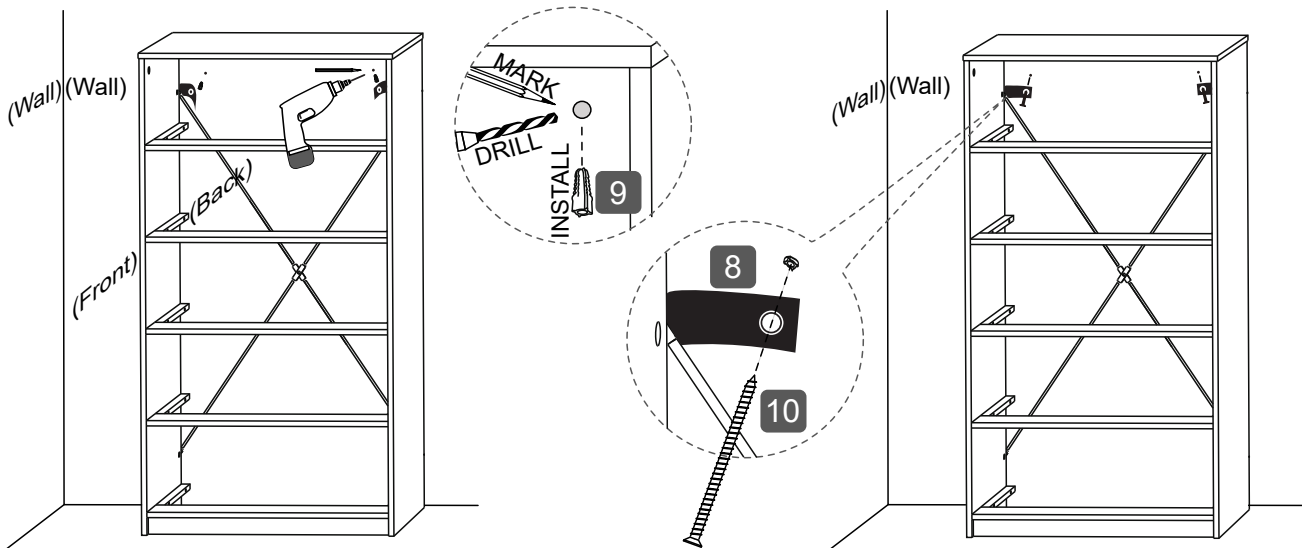
DO NOT SKIP THE INSTALLATION OF THE ANTI TIPPING DEVICE!

FIRST: On the back of the unit, attach the cross bars I to the side panels A and B with screws #4, with the Safety Strips #8 also installed AT THE TOP AND UNDER the cross bars.



THEN: Put the unit against the wall where it will stay, and use a driller (not included) to make 2 holes on the wall and insert the anchor #9 for the 2 safety strips.

LAST: Secure the safety strips to the anchors with screws #10.

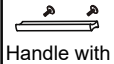

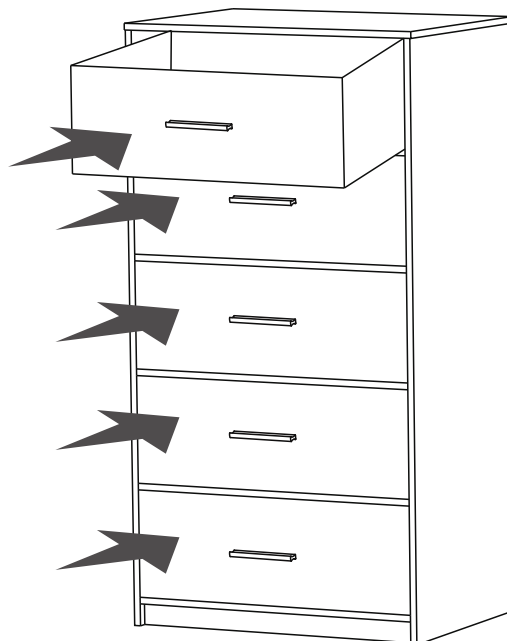
FIRST: Unfold the drawers J and place the bottoms K into each of them.



THEN: Attach the handles #6 to the drawers with their own screws.



FINALLY: Insert the drawers in to the unit.

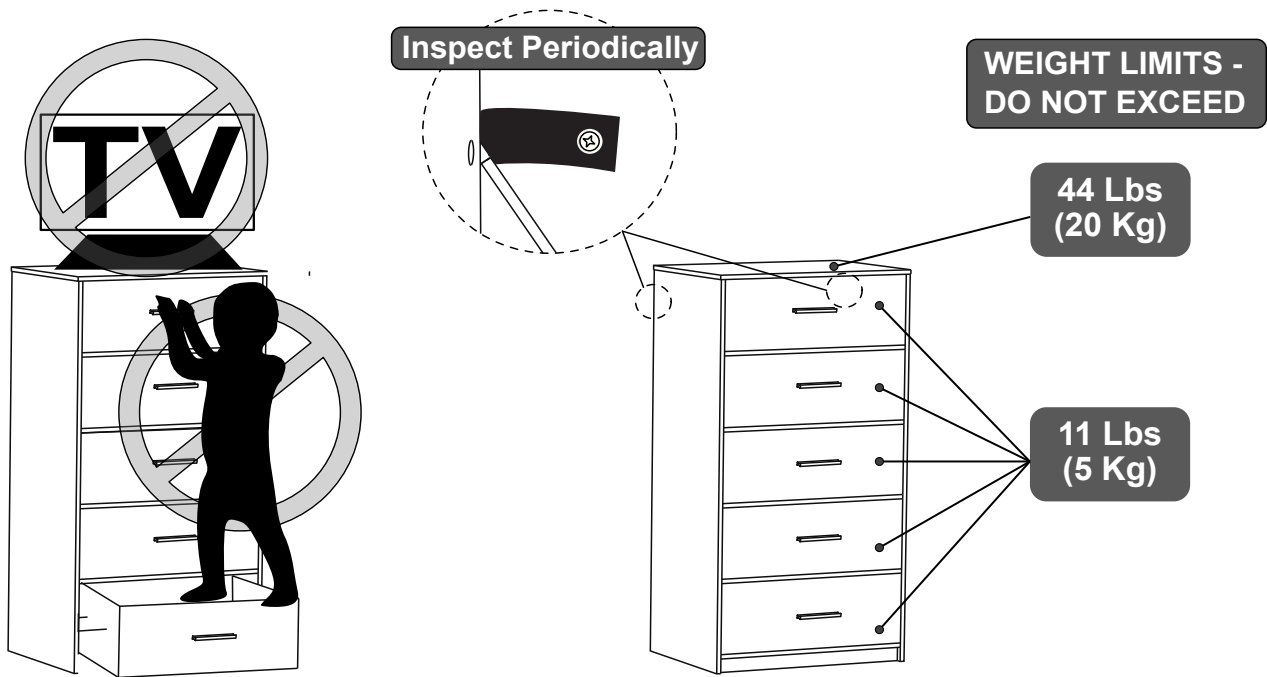


WARNINGS

Not paying attention to the following warnings could result in injuries.

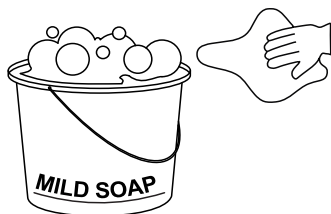
Children have died from furniture tip over. To reduce the risk of tip over:

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

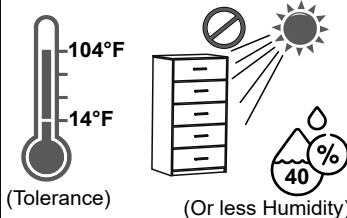
Clean with a cloth lightly damped in a solution of mild soap and water.



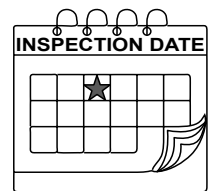
Do not use solvents or abrasive materials.
