Before assembling your headboard, please read through these instructions carefully and familiarize yourself with the different parts.











NOTE: WE INCLUDE SPARE HARDWARE IN CASE DAMAGE OCCURS DURING ASSEMBLY.

Step 1


Insert all wooden dowels (D) into the locator holes on (4)(5) and(6) as shown below.








Lay the left post (2) bracket face down on smooth surface. Connect top rail (4), mid rail (5) and bottom rail (6) as shown below, using JCB M6 X 110mm (A) and barrel nut (B). Tighten with the Allen wrench (E).




Guide the headboard panel (1) in carefully so that it won't jump out of its grooves.


Be sure it fits fully into the groove at the end (in the post) before fitting the other post.



Attach the right post (3) to headboard assembly as shown below, using JCB M6 X 110mm (A) and barrel nut (B).

Tighten with Allen wrench (E)



Metal bed frames are sold separately from wood headboards. The hardware shown on this page is supplied with your wood headboard for attaching the bed frame to the headboard. The metal bed frame is supplied with its own assembly instructions and hardware.

Step 1

Attach the headboard assembly to the metal bed frame using JCB M6 X 1" (F), flat washer (G), and split washer (H) then tighten with Allen wrench (E) as shown below.



# **Congratulations!**

Your bed is now ready for use.

To ensure lasting safety, we recommend that you periodically check that all screws are tight and all parts are secure.
